THE SUE STRAUGHN ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP AT THE PENSACOLA JUNIOR COLLEGE:

In the Fall, 2003, WEAR TV and the Pensacola Junior College Foundation announced the establishment of the Sue Straughn Endowed Scholarship in the celebration and appreciation of her 30 years of service. Established with a lead gift from WEAR, and supported by community partners, the Sue Straughn Endowed Scholarship has already received commitments of more than \$55,000.

The Friends of Sue Straughn having established a named endowment with Pensacola Junior College Foundation, Inc., designates that the income will provide scholarships for eligible students at Pensacola Junior College. The endowment and any subsequent contributions are to be held and invested by Pensacola Junior College Foundation, Inc. and administered according to specific guidelines.

Criteria: Student must demonstrate a financial need for supplemental funding. Student must have a minimum grade point average of 2.0. Student must be a United States citizen or resident alien. Student may be enrolled on a full-time or half-time basis. Scholarship will cover tuition, fees and/or books. Scholarship will be for two years, first right of renewal for second year – with first award fall 2004. Preference given to African American students.

As of September 30, 2005, three scholarships have been awarded.

Additionally, after the 2004-2005 fiscal year close, the audited report states that the balance of the Sue Straughn Endowed Scholarship balance as of June 30, 2005, was \$90,220.08.
