Over the past year our moms, dads, grandmas, and grandpas have suffered the most through this whole pandemic. This last week the New Mexico visitation guidelines have changed. In this show well talk about what those changes are. Some of those changes include: Outdoor visitation remains the preferred method of visiting, even for those who are fully vaccinated, as the environment poses a lower risk for transmission. Indoor visits are also allowed under the new guidance, with requirements surrounding the size of the room and number of occupants. If a resident is fully vaccinated, they may choose to have close contact with their visitor, this could include hugging, holding hands, etc., while wearing their mask and washing/sanitizing their hands afterwards. Communal dining and social activities are also now allowed, so long as social distancing requirements continue to be followed. All testing, infection control measures, and public health instructions (like mask wearing and social distancing- 6ft for those wearing masks and 12ft for residents who are unable to be masked) remain in place and must be followed. If there is an outbreak, the facility must pause visitation until all requirements in the guidance have been met.
