1. POLICE, THE COURT SYSTEM AND CRIME

AMERICA'S MOST WANTED-Network/Public Affairs-Saturdays 8-9 p.m.: One hour show each week that asks for the public's help finding criminals police are looking for that are still on the run.

FOX NEWS AT 9 Local/News-Thursday, April 24, 2008, 9-9:30 p.m.: There is a potential scam involving a Marble Rock family who lost three children. The Floyd county Sheriff's office was contacted by a friend of the family about someone dropping off donation cans or going up to people for donations in 3 different northern Iowa counties. A :35 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9 Local/News-Friday, April 25, 2008, 9-9:30 p.m.: A former Illinois police officer of the law is in jail for abusing young boys. Donald Rager was the most dangerous and prolific sex offender the judge in the case had ever encountered in state or federal court. He will spend the next 31 years in federal prison for traveling to Iowa to have sex with a 13 year-old boy. A 2:45 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9 -Local/News-Wednesday, April 30, 2008, 9-10 pm: A local drowning is being connected to possible serial killers. Two retired New York City police detectives believe a series of drownings across the country are connected. They believe a group of men are responsible for the deaths of 40 young in 11 different states, including Iowa. A 1:30 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9 -Local/News-Sunday, June 1, 2008, 9-10 p.m.: An Iowa City man caught with huge quantities of marijuana claims he planned turning the drug into compost- that according to the Johnson County Sheriff's office.. A :20 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9 -Local/News-Sunday, June 1, 2008, 9-10 p.m.: Hundreds of workers have been sentenced after the biggest immigration raid in US history, but not company official have yet to face any charges and some critics including Congressman Bruce Braley say that needs to change. FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Sunday April 20, 2008, 9-9:30 p.m.: Environmental opposition did not stop the Iowa Utilities Board from giving preliminary approval to a proposed coal-fired energy plant. The \$1.5 billion plant will be built in Marshalltown. A :38 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Friday, April 25, 2008, 9-9:30 p.m.: The Waterloo City Council voted to annex 347 acres of land on the city's northwest side and rezone it to build a L.S. Power coal powered plant in Waterloo. A :25 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Sunday, April 27, 2008, 9-9:30 p.m.: After flood waters recede, the cleanup begins. The most important thing to do when your basement floods is dry it out. You must remove all big items such as couches etc, then the next thing is to drain the water, remove carpet and dry out using a dehumidifier for 36-72 hours. The last step is to have people come in to use processed cleaners to clean floors and walls to make sure no mold develops. A 1:20 report.
