**1. POLICE, THE COURT SYSTEM AND CRIME**

**AMERICA'S MOST WANTED**-Network/Public Affairs-Saturdays 8-9 p.m.: One hour show each week that asks for the public's help finding criminals police are looking for that are still on the run.

**FOX NEWS AT 9** Local/News-Tuesday, October 30, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Hundreds of women have taken advantage of Night Ride, a free weekend service from the University of Iowa Police to drive women home to prevent assaults. A :20 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9** Local/News-Wednesday, October 31, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: The Iowa Board of Regents voted to arm campus police at all three of Iowa's public universities, reversing a 40-year-old policy that prohibited them from carrying guns. A :40 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9** -Local/News-Tuesday, November 27, 2007, 9-9:30 pm: Dubuque has been having trouble with criminals washing \$5 bills and turning them into \$100 bills, and now bogus \$50 may be circulating as well. These criminals are taking \$5 bill and bleaching them out and turning them into counterfeit bill. A 1:15 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9** -Local/News-Wednesday, November 28, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: There are criminal profilers in Iowa who try and solve crimes. Iowa's serial killers often come from difficult childhoods and broken homes. But despite over a century of practice, when it comes to profiling and predicting, there remains room for growth. A 2:45 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9** -Local/News-Tuesday, December 4, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: There is concern over growing violence inside two Eastern Iowa High Schools. Both City High and West High are seeing a high number of fights this year, with more and more of them between groups of students. The Iowa City School Board is getting feedback from the community on putting uniformed police officers in those schools, but there are no formal discussions between the district and the Iowa City Police Department. A 1:05 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9** -Local/News-Tuesday, December 4, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: The University of Northern Iowa is gearing up to help keep its campus in the loop. UNI is asking students and employees to update their emergency contact information. The University hopes to start testing an emergency alert system in February. A :20 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9** -Local/News-Thursday, December 6, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Shooting rampages like the one at a mall in Omaha are renewing the debate over gun control in America, with the two sides disagreeing over whether new laws might deter future acts of violence or simply reduce Americans' constitutional rights.. A 2:10 report.

**2. EDUCATION AND CHILDREN**

**FOX NEWS AT 9** -Local/News-Friday October 26, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: It's no secret that girls can be mean, and their victims are usually each other. To arrest that behavior before it starts, a new program called "Girls on the Run" in Johnson county is targeting girls between the ages of 8 and 11. Twice a week, these girls get together and listen to talks, do group activities and run, all to improve their self esteem. A 1:15 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9**-Local/News-Saturday October 27, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: The Iowa Board of Regents will consider an increase in tuition by 3-4% for in-state undergraduates at Iowa's three main universities. The largest increase will come for undergraduates at the University of Iowa where tuition and fees will increase by \$251- a four percent jump. A :45 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9**-Local/News-Monday October 29, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: A British newspaper says it found children as young as 10 making GAP clothes in a sweatshop in India, clothes the GAP planned to sell in the West. GAP stopped working with 23 factories last year because of violations found by its inspectors. A :18 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9**-Local/News-Monday October 29, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: The number of homeless students in both Iowa City and Cedar Rapids has been increasing. Last year Iowa City had 729 homeless students, which is 45 more than the year before. A 2:20 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9**-Local/News-Monday October 29 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Doctors say autism is one of the most difficult disorders to diagnose and early detection is key. That is why the American Academy of Pediatrics is recommending in their November journal that all children be tested for autism before the age of 2. Early detection and specialized therapy can lessen the severity of autism. A 1:45 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9**-Local/News-Thursday November 1, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Iowa has one of the lowest high school drop out rates in the nation. Nearly one in ten American high schools is a dropout factory, however in Iowa only eight out of 347 schools are given that distinction. A dropout factory is a school where no more than 60% of students who enter as freshmen make it to their senior year. A :25 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9**-Local/News-Friday November 30, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Students sometimes complain when they are in school that they feel like they are in prison. In some prisons, like the Newton Correctional Facility, there are classes conducted in the prison library. The inmates read works by established authors and even get their own work critiqued. A 3:00 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9**-Local/News-Saturday December 1, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: December 1<sup>st</sup> marks World Aids Day, and this year there is reason to celebrate. Prevention programs begun around the world are having an impact, there are fewer infections and many more people are on life saving treatment. A :35 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9**-Local/News-Thursday December 6, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: For the first time in 14 years, the nation's teen birth rate is on the rise jumping by 3% from 2005 to 2006. Births to unmarried mothers hit a new high and the overall birth rate is at its highest level since 1971. A :40 report.

### 3. **HEALTHCARE**

**FOX NEWS AT 9** -Local/News-Tuesday October 30, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: New research out of the University of Arizona finds the strain that spurred the aids epidemic has been in American since 1969. A :40 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9**-Local/News-Wednesday October 31, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: A way to avoid cancer is by dropping extra weight. A pair of cancer research groups have released their ten recommendations for cancer prevention and number one on their list is watching your weight. A :35 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9**-Local/News-Tuesday November 27, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Cutting-edge surgeries are using lasers and robots, giving patients a faster, less painful path to health. In the future a doctor on earth could perform a surgery in space. A 2:10 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9**-Local/News-Wednesday November 28, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Researchers at the University of Iowa say mortality rates are improving in all cancer categories, with double digit gains for prostate, breast and colo-rectal cancers. While over 57,000 Iowans died from cancer from 1997 to 2005, improvements resulted in nearly 3100 saved lives in that same period. A :25 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9**-Local/News-Wednesday November 28, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: The Faculty Senate at the University of Iowa is backing a campus-wide ban on smoking. Right now, smoking is banned inside buildings and outside-within 25 feet of all buildings. A :35 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9**-Local/News-Thursday November 29, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Next month, an arm of the World Health Organization will classify shift work as a “probable” carcinogen. That will put shift work in the same category as cancer-causing agents like ultraviolet radiation. One possible reason- night shift work disrupts the body’s natural rhythms of sleep and awake and the production of cancer-fighting melatonin, which is primarily produced at night.. A :45 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9**-Local/News-Friday, November 30, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: December 1 is World Aids Day. More than 2000 people in Iowa are being treated for HIV and aids. 37% of aids cases are undiagnosed in Iowa- many are in their teens and 20’s. A 1:10 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9**-Local/News-Sunday, December 2, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Researchers have found napping combats sleepiness better and more effectively than a cup of coffee. A :35 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9**-Local/News-Tuesday, December 4, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: A new report compiled by Families USA says one in four people with insurance have trouble paying their medical bills or are still paying off that debt. The number of Iowa families spending more than 25% of their pre-tax income on health care costs has increased by 83,000 people which is equal to the entire population of Sioux City. A :45 report.

#### **4      NEED FOR ECONOMIC GROWTH**

**FOX NEWS AT 9**-Local/News-Monday, October 29, 2007, 9-9:30 pm: Iowa’s tax amnesty programs ends Wed.Oct 31<sup>st</sup>. Today, the state has collected more applications than any other day

so far, but the amount of money collected is much lower than projected. After Wed Oct 31<sup>st</sup>, taxpayers will have to pay the full amount of interest due and be eligible for potential civil and criminal prosecution. A 1:40 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9**-Local/News-Tuesday, October 30, 2007, 9-9:30 pm.: Two developers from Minnesota and another from Des Moines submitted their qualifications to city staff for potential housing projects in downtown Cedar Rapids. The city owns several pieces of property that could be sold to make way for the housing units, some of them along the river. A :25 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9**-Local/News-Wednesday October 31, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Iowa has the 9<sup>th</sup> highest foreclosure rate in the nation. That is in spite of some reports saying the state has been buffered from predatory lenders and ballooning foreclosures. In 2000, Linn county registered 82 foreclosures. In 2003 that number increased to 210 and last year, the increase went to 292. In the first 10 month of this year, there have been 257. A 1:20 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9**-Local/News-Wednesday October 31, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: The higher education price index has been increasing at a more rapid rate than the rate of inflation. With inflation rates at universities at about 4% and the rate of inflation in the US at about 3%, it is more expensive to be a college student than just your average citizen.. A 1:18 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9**-Local/News-Wednesday October 31, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: The Board of Regents has approved a new policy for naming buildings at state universities. It requires "thorough due diligence" for potential donors. A :20 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9**-Local/News-Friday November 30, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: The deadline for matching funding for the \$140 million Earthpark project is Dec 1<sup>st</sup> and the development teams believes they have met all the requirements to receive those funds from the federal government. Earthpark has secured \$48 million in a federal grant and must match it or lose it all. A :45 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9**-Local/News-Sunday December 2, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: The IRS is seeking more than 600 Iowans whose tax refund checks worth more than \$430,000 were returned to the federal agency . The average check was worth about \$700. A :35 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9**-Local/News-Tuesday December 4, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Iowa faces a shortfall when it comes to funding its highways and bridge repairs. One solution is to increase the state's gas tax. But Governor Chet Culver is dead set against it. A 1:20 report.

## 5. **ENVIRONMENTAL CONCERNS**

**FOX NEWS AT 9**-Local/News-Friday October 26, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: In 2006 there were over 8000 collisions with deer, causing 9 deaths. While only 65 of those crashed involved motorcycles, they account for 8 of those nine fatalities. The DNR has a slogan- Don't veer for a deer. A :19 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9**-Local/News-Saturday October 27, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: DNR biologists contribute lower numbers of pheasants to a blizzard in March and above average rains in April and May. A :35 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9**-Local/News-Wednesday, October 31, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Cedar Rapids and Marion police and Linn county sheriff can send a message to any landline within the county in just minutes, which allows them to go to an area on the map and pin point an area on the map they want to make a notification to.. A 2:25 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9** -Local/News-Wednesday, October 31, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: A day after a Des Moines chemical plant went up in flames, initial environmental concerns are easing. Crews have been testing the air and city water systems all day and have found no threat to the public. A2:10 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9** -Local/News- Sunday November 25, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Central Iowa Power Coop and Corn Belt Power Coop will join Alliant Energy to operate a new 630 megawatt plant in Marshalltown. A 1:20 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9** -Local/News- Tuesday November 27, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: There are only 2 plant in the world like it- it's called the Iowa Stores Energy Park which is a \$200 million project that will harness the wind's energy and store it for future use. They will take wind energy from wind turbines and use that energy to drive motor driven compressors which push air deep into the ground where rock formations will store the compressed air. When we need more energy, the air will be released and a turbine will convert it into electricity, enough to power about 75, 000 homes A 1:50 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9** -Local/News- Wednesday November 28, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: The Office of Energy Independence says Iowa's power fund could help develop the state's wind and solar industries. Iowa is the nation's biggest producer of ethanol and in the top three in biodiesel and wind energy. State leaders are counting on the \$100 million power fund to further develop home-grown energy from bio-fuels, solar and win. A 1:10 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9** -Local/News- Wednesday November 28, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Over 90% of our tap water comes from surface water which is from a lake, stream or a river. The Iowa Legislature Task Force calls for creating a water resourced council headed by the Governor and investing \$13.5 million to monitor and maintain Iowa's watersheds. A 2:45 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9** -Local/News- Wednesday November 28, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: After 8 months of receiving reports and petitions from the volunteer group "Animal Welfare Foundation of Iowa", the Jones county board of Supervisors denied a request to provide county land for an animal shelter. A 2:10 report.

**FOX NEWS AT 9** -Local/News- Sunday December 2, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: We all need to have a greener Christmas if we are going to save the planet. There are all kinds of post consumer products available from led lights to organic cosmetics and body care products. A 1:37 report.
