1. POLICE, THE COURT SYSTEM AND CRIME

AMERICA'S MOST WANTED-Network/Public Affairs-Saturdays 8-9 p.m.: One hour show each week that asks for the public's help finding criminals police are looking for that are still on the run.

GOOD DAY IOWA Local/News-Wednesday, April 25, 2007, 7-9 a.m.: The Iowa Senate has approved a proposal to lower the state's threshold for drunken boating. Under the bill, boaters will be held to the same standards as motorists when drinking. A :25 report.

GOOD DAY IOWA -Local/News-Wednesday, May 30, 2007, 7-9 a.m.: Iowa now has new guidelines clarifying Iowa's flag desecration rule. Governor Culver signed a bill this week specifying that showing disrespect to the flag means to "deface, defile, mutilate or trample." A :31 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9 -Local/News-Wednesday, May 30, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: In 2005, almost 700 Linn county residents were charged with domestic violence and of those only 191 were convicted as charged. To put more offenders behind bars, several Linn county agencies, including the sheriff's department, Department of Human Services and The Child Protection Center are taking a hard look at their systems. A 2:05 report.

GOOD DAY IOWA-Local/News-Thursday, May 31, 2007, 7-9 a.m.: 2nd District Congressman Dave Loebsack met with police departments to talk about the challenges they face, one of which is funding. The House of Representatives has pledged \$600 million a year over the next 6 years to hire 50,000 police officers and \$350 million a year for technology grants. Loebsack believes this money would provide a boost to Eastern Iowa if it passes the Senate. A 1:45 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9 -Local/News-Friday, June 1, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: A new identity theft scam has surfaced, one that preys on the fears of the families of the men and women serving in Iraq. The scammer claims the spouse's husband, wife, daughter or son has been injured and that he or she has been med-evacuated to a military hospital in Germany and they need the injured's social security number and date of birth in order to start critical medical treatment. A 1:41 report.

2. EDUCATION AND CHILDREN

FOX NEWS AT 9 -Local/News-Tuesday April 24, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Kirkwood Community College's slogan reflects a growing change at two-year schools across the nation. They're starting to compete for high school graduates. A 1:32 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Thursday April 26, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Thousand of students graduate each May from Iowa Universities and colleges and enter the job force. More and more graduates are getting their diplomas and moving out of the state. The University of Iowa Career Services has started a new program call "Consider Iowa" to showcase all the state has to offer. A 1:41 report.

GOOD DAY IOWA-Local/News-Thursday April 26, 2007, 7-9 a.m.: Congress is aiming to keep America at the forefront of education. The Senate has voted to authorize an additional \$16 billion for math and science programs over the next 4 years. A :27 report.

GOOD DAY IOWA-Local/News-Thursday April 26, 2007, 7-9 a.m.: The Center for Screen Time Awareness claims that 40% of Americans frequently or always watch television during dinner. It's national turn-off the TV week across the country and kids are signing pledges to get away from their TV screens. A 1:20 report.

GOOD DAY IOWA-Local/News-Thursday April 26, 2007, 7-9 a.m.: Smokers at the University of Iowa will have to stay at least 25 feet away from any campus building by July 1, 2007. An all-out smoking ban could come by July 1, 2008. A :43 report.

GOOD DAY IOWA-Local/News-Friday April 27, 2007, 7-9 a.m.: Governor Culver has signed a \$250 million boost for teacher salaries. It will raise Iowa's teacher salaries to the national average. A :51 report.

GOOD DAY IOWA-Local/News-Sunday April 29, 2007, 7-9 a.m.: The Iowa Student Loan Liquidity Corporation is facing increasing scrutiny from every level of state government, all at a time when Iowa college students are dealing with one of the highest debt loads in the country. A :25 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Monday April 30, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Tooth decay in young children had been going down for the last 40 years, but today's preschoolers are changing that. There is a rise in tooth decay in baby teeth according to a recent study because of the increase of kids eating more processed snacks, and drinking more bottled water than tap water which has fluoride. A :45 report.

GOOD DAY IOWA-Local/News-Monday April 30, 2007, 7-9 a.m.: The Safe Kids Worldwide Organization reports more than 2000 children will die in accidents in these warmer months, most of which are preventable which include car accidents and drownings. A :37 report.

GOOD DAY IOWA-Local/News-Wednesday May 30, 2007, 7-9 a.m.: The Internet has become a social pipeline for teens to network with friends and share photos, but they may be sharing their personal information with the wrong person. A 1:37 report.

3. HEALTHCARE

GOOD DAY IOWA -Local/News-Wednesday April 25, 2007, 7-9 a.m.: The Iowa Department of Human Services is trying to figure out how to keep 13,000 children from losing health coverage. Governor Culver asked the agency to address this issue, which is rooted in a \$13.4 million shortfall. Congress has approved legislation that would cover the shortfall, but it's attached to the controversial Iraq war funding bill. A :21 report.

GOOD DAY IOWA -Local/News-Wednesday April 25, 2007, 7-9 a.m.: Accessible healthcare is a commodity 52,000 Iowa children are currently living without. Governor Culver has announced plans to provide health insurance to at least 7500 of those children by next year, and more than 50,000 within the next four years. Governor Culver is asking the Iowa Legislature to set aside \$9 million of the state's recent cigarette tax increase to pay for his plan. A :29 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Friday April 27, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: More than 500 students in the Iowa City school district don't have health insurance. To make sure these children get their necessary check-ups and immunizations, the school district has started "The Healthy Kids Community Care Clinic". The free clinic is staffed by doctors from the University of Iowa College of Medicine and volunteers. A :30 report.

GOOD DAY IOWA -Local/News-Sunday April 29, 2007, 7-9 a.m.: The KFC chain has announced that all 5500 of its US restaurants have stopped frying chicken in artery-clogging trans fat. The chain is switching to a new soybean oil believed less likely to cause heart disease. A :22 report.

GOOD DAY IOWA -Local/News-Wednesday, May 30, 2007, 7-9 a.m.: Both St. Luke's Hospital and the University of Iowa Children's Hospitals are using the "Kangaroo Care" for premature babies while they are hospitalized. The neo-natal intensive care units mimic the comfort of the womb. A 1:47 report.

GOOD DAY IOWA -Local/News-Wednesday May 30, 2007, 7-9 a.m.: All Iowans could have health coverage within 5 years. Governor Chet Culver says the Iowa Legislature established a commission this year that will consider ways to provide health coverage to all Iowans. A :45 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Friday, June 1, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Scientists have known that mothers who smoke can harm their fetuses. Now, they have evidence that fathers can potentially damage their offspring. Canadian researchers found smoking caused changes in the DNA sequence of a father's sperm cells, which could potentially be inherited by offspring. A :36 report.

4 NEED FOR ECONOMIC GROWTH

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Saturday, April 28, 2007, 9-9:30 pm: The Legislature has approved a plan to give Iowans a one-time tax break. The Tax Amnesty Program will allow people to pay late taxes with limited penalties and no criminal charges. A :25 report.

GOOD DAY IOWA -Local/News-Sunday April 29, 2007, 7-9 a.m.: Lawmakers adjourned early after putting the finishing touches on a \$6 billion state budget. This session, lawmakers reached many goals of Governor Chet Culver, including a pay raise for teachers, an increased minimum wage and investment in alternative fuels. But many Republicans remain skeptical, they don't know how Democrats will come up with the extra \$1 billion in spending over the next 2 years. A :20 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Monday, April 30, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Airplane manufacturer, "Airbus" named Rockwell Collins one of its top ten suppliers. Rockwell Collins is the only US based business to make the list. A :26 report.

GOOD DAY IOWA--Local/News-Wednesday May 30, 2007, 7-9 a.m.: Iowa is teaming up with Kansas to create a joint scratch off lottery game called "Midwest Millions." The \$10 tickets will go on sale in September. A :37 report.

GOOD DAY IOWA-Local/News-Saturday, June 2, 2007, 7-9 a.m.: The Iowa State Treasury is bringing in more money than it's used to. According to the Legislative Services Agency, Iowa took in almost \$850 million this May, setting a new record. A :20 report.

GOOD DAY IOWA-Local/News-Sunday, June 3, 2007, 7-9 a.m.: Iowa currently leads the nation in corn based ethanol production, but some say the state's booming business could get even bigger. A report by the Iowa Renewable Fuels Association predicts last year's economic impact from ethanol will produce nearly 600 new jobs in Iowa over the next three years in both the biofuels and biotechnology industries. A :19 report.

5. ENVIRONMENTAL CONCERNs

GOOD DAY IOWA-Local/News-Wednesday April 25, 2007, 7-9 a.m.: Tainted pet food has been fed to hogs in as many as six states. Food safety officials say they've quarantined hogs at farms in California, New York, North Carolina, South Carolina, Utah and possibly Ohio. A :32 report.

GOOD DAY IOWA-Local/News-Thursday April 26, 2007, 7-9 a.m.: There's a motion by Iowa's Secretary of Agriculture to push legislation through Congress that would allow Iowa meat and poultry producers to bypass USDA inspections. A :32 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Friday, April 27, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: In more than 20 states, beekeepers have noticed that their honeybees have vanished without a clue. A :39 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Friday, April 27, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Some are happy with the Legislature, but some feel a state law isn't enough to solve global warming. Biologists don't know what the real answer is to climate change. A 1:34 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News- Saturday April 28, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: One piece of legislation the Governor has inked is a tracking system that will help the state monitor air pollution. The

new program will create a Global Warming Advisory Council which will develop strategies to reduce Iowa's global warming pollution. A :23 report.

GOOD DAY IOWA -Local/News-Sunday April 29, 2007, 7-9 a.m.: A shortage of farm veterinarians is putting Iowa at risk for more disease, potentially endangering human health and risking the nation's food supply. A :23 report.

GOOD DAY IOWA -Local/News-Monday April 30, 2007, 7-9 a.m.: President Bush and top European officials signed an agreement to promote alternative fuels and energy efficiency, with a promise of cooperation on emerging technologies. A :31 report.

GOOD DAY IOWA -Local/News-Monday April 30, 2007, 7-9 a.m.: This time of year, throughout the rescue industry is known as the "Drowning Season" because in the spring the water is much colder, and the opportunity for hypothermia is much more prevalent. A 1:44 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9 -Local/News-Thursday, May 31, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Farms and businesses in Iowa are getting some federal help to buy more efficient grain-drying systems. A :45 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9 -Local/News-Friday, June 1, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Earthpark, Iowa's rainforest, has 6 months to raise \$50 million to match fund from a federal grant or the money disappears. A 1:40 report.
