The VA has hired more people to expand this program. In 2012 18% of vets in our area used this program; the goal in 2013 is to grow to 30%.

PDST is the BIG Problem right now! The VA is now seeing Vietnam Vets coming in as they now view the VA as an open organization which can help them.
