-Clinical: patients can receive mental health care, along with diabetes counseling, COPD and transplants follow-up. By visiting a teleconferencing center the vet can have one-on-one counseling with health professionals without coming to a VA hospital.

The VA has hired more people to expand this program. In 2012 18% of vets in our area used this program; the goal in 2013 is to grow to 30%.

PDST is the BIG Problem right now! The VA is now seeing Vietnam Vets coming in as they now view the VA as an open organization which can help them.
