1. POLICE, THE COURT SYSTEM AND CRIME

AMERICA'S MOST WANTED-Network/Public Affairs-Saturdays 8-9 p.m.: One hour show each week that asks for the public's help finding criminals police are looking for that are still on the run.

FOX NEWS AT 9 Local/News-Friday, July 27, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: A Johnson county judge says extra parole time for convicted sex offenders is unfair and unconstitutional, and is refusing to impose mandatory parole time for 2 men convicted of indecent exposure. State Senator Rob Hogg says there's a good reason he and other legislators passed a law requiring extra parole time for certain sex offenders, 10 years to life, on top of jail time. We need to closely supervise people who have had sex offenses, to stop further offenses. A 1:50 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9 Local/News-Sunday, July 29, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: The Iowa State Patrol is going high tech with their accident investigations with technology that enables them to re-create the scene of an accident "to scale" on a computer. Officials will now measure and document an entire accident site, from tire marks to eyewitness interviews. The state purchased 16 accident kits at \$8700 each. A :45 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9 -Local/News-Tuesday, July 31, 2007, 9-9:30 pm: House lawmakers voted to force themselves to be more open about how they fund pet projects and how lobbyists fund them. The Democratically drafted bill requires disclosure of campaign donations lobbyists collect for members of Congress. It bars lobbyists from giving gifts, meals and tickets to Congressmen and women and requires a two day notice before slipping pet projects or ear-marks into big Senate spending measures. A :31 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9 -Local/News-Wednesday, August 29, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: A district court judge has approved the \$179 million settlement in the Iowa class action lawsuit against Microsoft. A :30 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9 -Local/News-Wednesday, August 29, 2007, 7-9 a.m.: A Polk county judge has blown down Iowa's ban on same sex marriage. Judge Robert Hanson ruled that 6 same sex couples who filed for marriage licenses are in fact entitled to them. The couples were initially denied the license. Though the judge declared the law unconstitutional and invalid, same sex couples are not yet allowed to marry in Iowa. A 2:45 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9 -Local/News-Thursday, September 20, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: A state commissioned report says top managers at Iowa Workforce Development had biases about the interview skills of black job applicants, which has caused less blacks to get hired. The report included statistics that showed fewer blacks than whites are being hired by Iowa Workforce A :20 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9 -Local/News-Saturday, September 22, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Representatives from University student organizations say they'll continue making strides for student safety as long

as necessary. Enrollment in on-campus self-defense classes and other safety related programs is also on the rise. A 1:45 report.

2. EDUCATION AND CHILDREN

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Monday July 30, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Iowa State University is teaming up with the Iowa Lottery to give fans a chance to see the September 15th Iowa-Iowa State football game at Jack Trice Stadium. In the promotion, 10 lucky people will receive 4 tickets each to the interstate rivalry and one of those 10 will be the lucky winner of 2008 ISU football season tickets. A 1:32 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Monday July 30, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: There are renewed calls for more food inspectors in the United States and tighter regulations on what comes into this country from China. A 1:45 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Monday July 30, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: The Iowa City school district has contracted with a new transportation company to drive nearly 6000 students to and from school each day. A :18 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Tuesday July 31, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: As soon as school kicks off for the '07-'08 school year, the question of packing or buying lunch is one you will have each morning for your school age children. Nutritionists say balanced lunches and healthy after school snacks are essential. A 1:20 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Tuesday July 31 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: James Merchant, the Dean of the College of Public Health, says a \$15 million naming gift offer from the Wellmark Foundation was "embarrassingly small" and would significantly undervalue the College. A 2:08 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Wednesday August 29, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: The new Generation Iowa Commission is made up of younger Iowans from all across the state with different backgrounds. They plan to solve Iowa's projected worker shortage and stop young Iowans from leaving the state after college. A 2:10 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Saturday September 22, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: A Dubuque Senior High School has a trial program that lets half the school work out everyday each semester. The program emphasizes cardiovascular exercise, weight training and rewards that fit kids with fun games. A :25 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Saturday September 22, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Iowa's 2 biggest public universities will begin marketing credit cards to their students, a deal that will generate millions of dollars for the schools' alumni organizations. University of Iowa officials will give Bank of America access to mailing addresses, telephone numbers and e-mails of students and parents as well as fans who buy tickets to Hawkeye football and basketball games. A :20 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Sunday September 23, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: The College Cost Reduction and Access Act is the largest investment in student financial aid since the GI bill. The Act gives Iowa students \$430 million in loans and pell grant scholarships over 5 years. A 2:30 report.

3. HEALTHCARE

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Thursday July 26, 2007, 7-9 a.m.: David Walker, US Controller General and head of the US Accountability Office says without significant health care reform, the US could be headed for financial ruin. He said voters need to force presidential candidates to address the tough issues of budget and trade deficits and health care reform. A :40 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Sunday July 29, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Des Moines University medical students helped several Des Moines students get ready to go back to school with free physicals. The experience is hands on instead of merely reading books and taking exams. A 2:15 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Monday July 30, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: State health officials said 19 cases of the waterborne disease *crypto-spora-deeosis* have been confirmed. Symptoms include diarrhea, dehydration, cramps, fever and vomiting. The disease is usually contracted when people swallow untreated water in pools, rivers and lakes. A :36 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Tuesday July 31, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Doctors at Boston Medical Center say they might have found a cure for type one diabetes, a disease that affects millions of Americans. They say they've discovered a three drug regimen that stops the destruction of beta cells in mice. A :45 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Tuesday August 28, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: A government survey has found only 12% of teens got a meningitis shot that is recommended by US health officials. The survey also finds that only 11% got another relatively new shot, one that guards against tetanus, diphtheria and whooping cough. A :19 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Tuesday August 28, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: The months of August and September are the peak months for West Nile in Iowa and officials say to take precautions to avoid getting the disease like emptying all standing water around your yard and staying indoors when mosquitos are most likely to be out.. A :19 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Tuesday, August 28, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Lance Armstrong held a cancer forum in Cedar Rapids for both the Democratic and Republican presidential candidates to see how they would deal with cancer research and prevention. A 1:40 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Thursday, September 20, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: The University of Iowa is part of a consortium looking at a regional medical campus in Des Moines. A :19 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Saturday, September 22, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Ten days before the state children's health insurance program called HAWK-I, is set to expire, President Bush and Congress are clashing on funding for it. HAWK-I provides health insurance for more than 20,000 Iowa children. A :45 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Saturday, September 22, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: There is a recall of over one million baby cribs that were sold under the brands Simplicity and Graco. A :22 report.

4 NEED FOR ECONOMIC GROWTH

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Monday, July 30, 2007, 9-9:30 pm: Wal Mart had appealed their 2007 assessed value of the Iowa City store located on Highway One West. The Iowa City Board of Review has already lowered the assessed value of the property from \$5.7 million to \$5.5 million, a move that saved Wal Mart more than \$7,000 in property taxes. A :25 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Tuesday, July 31, 2007, 9-9:30 pm: Cab fares in Cedar Rapids increased by 80% at the end of July. Both of the city's taxi companies- Yellow Cab and Century Cab say the jump in price is driving people away. A 1:20 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Tuesday July 31, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: The Wall Street Journal, owned by Dow Jones and the Bancroft family, who control the company's voting shares have agreed to sell The Wall Street Journal to Rupert Murdoch for \$5 billion. A :20 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Tuesday August 28, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Rockwell Collins is teaming up with Boeing to develop the newest advanced tanker- a plane designed to refuel other aircraft. Rockwell would provide the navigation systems for the KC-767. If they are awarded the contract, it would bring 1600 jobs to Iowa and generate \$60 million every year. A 1:36 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Saturday September 22, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: The Iowa Speedway wrapped up its first full year of racing, from Indy cars to stock cars. A 1:45 report.

5. ENVIRONMENTAL CONCERNS

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Friday July 27, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Changes are on tap for the makers of Aquafina. A group called Corporate Accountability International has been pressuring bottled water sellers to disclose their water's source. Now its bottles are labeled "P-W-S", but owners say new labels will spell out "public water source", which is tap water A :19 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Friday July 27, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Ethanol producers are loving a drop in the price of corn, whereas farmers are not as prices continue to fall. This year Iowa is expected to harvest nearly 93 million acres of corn, setting a record high for corn production in the state. A :19 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Sunday, July 29, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Defying a veto threat from President Bush, the US House passed legislation that combines billions in aid to farmers with funds for low income nutrition programs. A :29 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9-Local/News-Tuesday, July 31, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Cedar Valley Techworks has received another boost in federal funding, the time from Representative Bruce Braley who secured \$170,000 in a transportation bill to add to the Economic Development Administration who gave the project \$1.6 million in June. A:30 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9 -Local/News- Tuesday July 31, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: MidAmerican Energy, Iowa's largest energy company has received state approval to expand its wind energy capacity. The Iowa Utilities Board recently gave their approval for MidAmerican to add another 540 megawatts of wind power. A :20 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9 -Local/News- Tuesday August 28, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: Land owners in rural Marion will soon have a septic business from a neighbor, something they have been fighting to prevent. The Linn County Board of Adjustments voted to allow Miene Septic to build on North Center Point Road. A :20 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9 -Local/News- Saturday September 22, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: The Iowa Department of Natural Resources currently oversees Iowa's environmental issues. But several environmental groups don't think the state run department is doing its job to keep the air and water clean. So they filed a petition to turn responsibility over to the federal government. A 1:10 report.

FOX NEWS AT 9 -Local/News- Saturday September 22, 2007, 9-9:30 p.m.: In an effort to educate their consumers about alternate energy, Maquoketa Valley Electric Company just started fueling their office building using a wind turbine. Wind power on a personal scale which won't come cheap, setting a person back about \$10,000. But with an annual savings of \$300 a year in energy costs, customers will begin to see a return on their investment in about 10 years. A 1:15 report.
