1/23/19 @ 8:30 AM: We discussed the upcoming “Lindsay Community Blood Drive” with coordinator Lacy Curry. Topics included the importance of giving blood, the current shortage of blood units in our state, and raising awareness of the how blood donations save lives. (15 minutes)
