4/8/20 @ 8:30 AM: "Point of View" guest was OKC Teen Challenge Coordinator Lowlan Breaux. We discussed the impact that COVID-19 was having on the campus of the Addiction Rehab facility, and how people could help. Also talked about how addiction could worsen during a pandemic. (25 minutes)

5/20/20 @ 8:30 AM: Spoke (via telephone) with Lindsay Community Blood Drive coordinator Lacy Curry. Topics of discussion included the importance of continuing regular blood drives. Need for blood donations after a decline during the winter months. (15 minutes)

5/26/20 @ 8:30 AM: Legislative update from State Rep. Cindy Roe. Discussed current issues facing area communities, active legislation with impacts on the community. Rep. Roe also shared her perspectives, as a member of the healthcare industry, on the COVID-19 situation. (25 minutes)

6/5/20 @ 8:30 AM: POV guest was Cheryl Hendricks with Blanchard Chamber of Commerce. Discussion of Blanchard's annual May Daze Festival, what it means to the community,

and safety measures being taken to prevent spread of COVID-19. (20 minutes)

6/11/20 @ 8:30 AM: Interviewed Lindsay Swimming Pool Supervisor Paige Sutherland about the seasonal opening of the public pool. Topics of discussion included swimming lessons, water aerobics and operating hours. Also discussed the importance of teaching kids to swim at a young age to prevent accidental drownings. (20 minutes)
