During the previous quarter, the issues listed below have been significant to our community. We ran the responsive programming indicated to address them. This list is not exhaustive and the order does not reflect priority or significance.

ISSUE: Easter in the Pandemic

RESPONSIVE PROGRAMMING: Daily Hope "How the Resurrection Gives Us Hope - Parts 1, 2, & 3"

DATE / TIME: May 11, 2020 at 10am for 25 minutes

DESCRIPTION OF RESPONSIVE PROGRAMMING: You won't find many silver linings in the dark cloud that is the coronavirus outbreak, but there's one that could help nonprofit organizations struggling with reduced donations, and get you a break on your 2020 tax return.
