The attached is a compiled list of program descriptions of public affairs shows, which WLFL produced to serve the community's interest during the 1st quarter (April 1st through March 31, 2010) of the broadcast calendar year.

Community Calendar:

CW 22 Community Calendar

Local non-profit organizations utilize this community service project to promote local community events and activities. The events and activities included support group meetings to talk about important issues, and charity events that help raise money for important causes. The Community Calendar airs daily at 10am. It is 60 seconds in length and is comprised of 3 announcements at 20 seconds each.

In the 1st quarter, WLFL aired approximately 55 announcements for a total of 55 minutes of community announcements

Public Service Announcements:

In addition to the attached, WLFL aired public service announcements covering a number of topics which include the following subject matter: Crime, Drugs/Alcohol, Education, Employment/Economy, Environment, Health, Youth/Teens, Volunteering, Fitness, Family and Government, and DTV transition. During the 1st quarter of 2010, WLFL aired approximately 5 hours of public service announcements. These public service announcements range from 10 seconds to 60 seconds in length.
