The attached is a compiled list of program descriptions of public affairs shows, which WLFL produced to serve the community's interest during the 3rd quarter (July 1st through September 30 2019) of the broadcast calendar year.

Community Calendar:

CW 22 Community Calendar

Local non-profit organizations utilize this community service project to promote local community events and activities. The events and activities included support group meetings to talk about important issues, and charity events that help raise money for important causes. The Community Calendar airs daily at 10am. It is 60 seconds in length and is comprised of 3 announcements at 20 seconds each.

Public Service Announcements:

In addition to the attached, WLFL aired public service announcements covering a number of topics which include the following subject matter: Crime, Drugs/Alcohol, Education, Employment/Economy, Environment, Health, Youth/Teens, Volunteering, Fitness, Family and Government, and DTV transition. During the 3rd quarter of 2019, WLFL aired approximately 5 hours of public service announcements. These public service announcements range from 10 seconds to 60 seconds in length. The public service announcements aired daily between sign on to sign off seven days a week

Locally produced Public Service Announcements:

Creature Feature- each week we feature two animals that need homes with information on the animal and how viewers can adopt the animal. On average will air these spots twice a day.

Network produced Public Service Announcements:

We aired no Network produced Public Service Announcements during the 3rdguarter.

The show format includes a major investigative piece each week on topics ranging from immigration issues at home and abroad, government waste, national security concerns and vulnerabilities, whistleblower reports on government abuse and misdeeds. Full Measure is produced by and airs nationally on stations of the Sinclair Broadcast Group. It airs on WLFL on Sundays at 11a. The program also streams live on all Sinclair websites on Sundays at 9:30 a.m. ET.
