IPS SAYS MORE THAN HALF OF THEIR BUSES ARE AT LEAST 10 YEARS OLD AND MOST OF THOSE HAVE MORE THAN 100-THOUSAND MILES.

NOW TRANSPORTATION OFFICIALS WILL BE PHASING THOSE BUSES OUT WITH NEW PROPANE-FUELED BUSES. EACH BUS WILL COST THE DISTRICT 100-THOUSAND DOLLARS OVER THE NEXT FIX YEARS, IPS SAYS THAT INCLUDES THE LEASE-TO-OWN PAYMENTS FOR THE BUSES AND MAINTENANCE PROVIDED BY THE VENDOR. PROPANE WILL SAVE THE DISTRICT HUNDREDS OF THOUSANDS OF DOLLARS, IF NOT MORE, OVER THE BUSES LIFETIME.

DURING THE MOST RECENT INSPECTIONS BY INDIANA STATE POLICE OF I-P-S BUSES, HALF WERE APPROVED. THE REST EITHER REQUIRED REPAIRS OR WERE PUT OUT-OF-SERVICE.

A SPOKESPERSON SAYS, THIS COMES AFTER SEVERAL STATES PASSED LAWS ALLOWING PEOPLE TO REFUSE SERVICES TO OTHERS, BASED ON THEIR SEXUAL ORIENTATION OR GENDER IDENTITY.

WHILE THE NCAA DIDN'T NAME SPECIFIC STATES, NORTH CAROLINA AND MISSISSPPI HAVE RECENTLY PASSED LAWS THAT CRITICS SAY ALLOW DISCRIMINATION AGAINST THE LBGT COMMUNITY.

THE NEW POLICY MEANS ANY CITY BIDDING FOR OR HOSTING AN EVENT -- FROM THE FINAL FOUR EVEN TO CONFERENCES...WILL HAVE TO SHOW THE NCAA HOW EXACTLY IT WILL PROVIDE A ENVIRONMENT THAT IS SAFE, HEALTHY AND FREE OF DISCRIMINATION.

THE NCAA ALSO NO PROHIBITS CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS IN STATES WHERE GOVERNMENTS DISPLAY THE CONFEDERATE FLAG.

NOW, NCAA MEMBERS CANNOT HOST CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS IF THEIR SCHOOL NICKNAMES USE NATIVE AMERICAN IMAGERY CONSIDERED ABUSIVE OR OFFENSIVE. THE NCAA SAYS THE NEW POLICY IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY -- EVEN IN ANY CURRENT BIDDING FOR EVENTS.
