

Medical Notification Process

Gray Television Group, Inc. dba WJHG TV, WECP TV Panama City, FL

Per the rules of the FCC (47 CFR 15.242) full power stations are required to make a good faith effort to identify and notify health care facilities (e.g., hospitals, nursing homes, see 47 CFR 15.242(a)(1)) within the service area potentially affected by DTV operations.

Widelity was engaged to identify and to make a good faith effort to notify locations that met the criteria of the rules.

Using the D&B data, and NAICS codes, and using industry standard mapping software, Widelity used the Predicted Coverage Contours and identified the locations that were within the maximum Predicted Coverage Contour. This yielded 372 locations that met the following criteria:

- General medical and surgical hospitals
- Nursing and personal care
- Psychiatric hospitals
- Residential care
- Skilled nursing care facilities

The facilities were selected from the following codes:

NAICS Code 622 Hospitals

Industries in the Hospitals subsector provide medical, diagnostic, and treatment services that include physician, nursing, and other health services to inpatients and the specialized accommodation services required by inpatients. Hospitals may also provide outpatient services as a secondary activity. Establishments in the Hospitals subsector provide inpatient health services, many of which can only be provided using the specialized facilities and equipment that form a significant and integral part of the production process.

NAICS Code 623 Nursing and Residential Care Facilities

Industries in the Nursing and Residential Care Facilities subsector provide residential care combined with either nursing, supervisory, or other types of care as required by the residents. In this subsector, the facilities are a significant part of the production process and the care provided is a mix of health and social services with the health services being largely some level of nursing services.

The letters were mailed via the US Post Office. All addresses were verified for validity and compared to the USPS Move Update Service. The letters were bar coded and mailed with Full Service Intelligent Bar Codes. Letters that were returned from the US Post Office were researched individually and, where possible, addresses were corrected and the letters were resent.

Notice of Channel Change for UHF Digital Television Channels

You are receiving this letter because WJHG is changing broadcast channels from VHF Channel 7 (174-180 MHz) to UHF Channel 18 (494-500 MHz) and WECP is changing broadcast channels from UHF Channel 18 (494-500 MHz) to UHF Channel 29 (560-566 MHz). This change in channels may affect equipment in your facility. Please be sure that anyone in your facility who is responsible for the supervision or maintenance of the biomedical equipment receives a copy of this notification and the attachments.

Under authorization from the Federal Communications Commission (FCC), the stations listed above will be broadcasting on frequencies with the technical parameters listed in the following pages.

Per the rules of the FCC (47 CFR 15.242) full power stations are required to make a good faith effort to identify and notify health care facilities (e.g., hospitals, nursing homes, see 47 CFR 15.242(a)(1)) within the service area potentially affected by the DTV operations.

Widelity has been retained by the stations listed above to make the required good faith notifications to applicable facilities in their service areas. This letter is to notify health care facilities in the coverage area in the event that any electronic medical devices are affected by the radiofrequency (RF) field emitted by the transmitted DTV signals.

Your facility may have electronic biomedical devices that could be impacted by the DTV operations listed on the following pages. The FCC allows certain electronic biomedical devices to use unoccupied DTV frequencies on a secondary use basis. As a result of the secondary use status, your facility is responsible for identifying and resolving any potential radio frequency interference for the operations identified on the following pages.
