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WLAN provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- **PROJECTLYME.ORG:** TOPIC(S): SINCE 2011, PENNSYLVANIA HAS REPORTED THE MOST CASES OF LYME DISEASE IN THE WHOLE COUNTRY AND EACH YEAR THIS NUMBER KEEPS GOING UP. BEING BITTEN BY A TICK, VERY OFTEN RESULTS IN LYME DISEASE, WHICH IS A SERIOUS BACTERIAL INFECTION WHICH CAN STAY IN THE BODY FOR YEARS.
