To make the expansion a reality, the federal railroad administration will provide half a million dollars to each of the corridors for planning, made possible by the bipartisan infrastructure law. Senator brown says "good Amtrak service shouldn't be a privilege only for people on the coasts. These new routes would expand opportunities, help grow businesses and create jobs, and connect communities in Ohio and across the Midwest. In addition to the investment for planning, the Ohio corridors will receive priority in future funding competitions.
