One is currently a full time employee at Midwestern Broadcasting Company.
- ➤ Educational Tours of the radio stations Midwestern Broadcasting conducts regular educational group tours of the radio station facilities and studios. Groups range in age from elementary school through adults.
- ➤ Training of Management level personnel In 2020, Tammie Altshuler (Human Resources Manager and EEO Coordinator for all of Midwestern Broadcasting Company's radio stations) issued a complete review of EEO Policies and FCC Regulations to all Department Heads. That policy is reviewed annually for its application and effectiveness. It continues to provide managers with procedural instructions that are deemed worthy and effective.

➤ Review of EEO Files and Records – In 2020, an FCC Review of the Company's EEO policies and practices was made. It included inspection of the public files and of the EEO program information and records, and a written report to the Commission. The company had no problems or issues.
