The driver of the vehicle was later arrested and placed in the same juvenile hall.

National Issue – Studies have shown that people who have received the COVID-19 booster shot are more likely to get the virus than people who have never received the vaccine. A group of inmates were tested and turned out that inmates who received the vaccine was at 3.2% than others who didn't receive the vaccine at 2.7%. The infection rate was higher in elderly inmates over 65 years old.

The San Bernardino Superior Court blocked a new policy that would make teachers notify parents if their child had any gender confusion. This policy stems from a lawsuit filed by California General Rob Bonta who is investigating the situation, calling it "forced outing policy."

Jenna was sentenced to 5 years' probation, paying \$5,000 in restitution, and required to do 100 hours of community service.
