#### **Quarterly Ascertainment Summary – 4th Quarter 2023**

Attached is a report concerning KEZI-TV news stories, local programming, network programming and public service announcements aired by KEZI during 4th Quarter 2023, pertaining to key issues as determined by the KEZI -TV Community Relations department.

The seven main areas and issues listed below are identified from viewer comments, solicited community comment and ascertainment of interviews with community leaders.

### Public Service Announcements:

**KEZI-TV 9.1 (Eugene / Roseburg / Coos Bay / Corvallis)** contributed <u>1,566</u> public service announcements covering issues in the station's immediate community, and across Lane, Linn, Douglas, Benton and Coos Counties. KEZI-TV 9.1 also contributed a minimum of one story per 30 minutes of news covering the above issues (samples available on individual request).

**KEZI 9.2 (Eugene + Limited DMA Viewing)** contributed <u>1,546</u> public service announcements covering issues across KEZI's DMA. KEZI 9.2 promotes local, regional and national news coverage on KEZI-TV of key community issues.

#### **Emergency Alert System:**

**KEZI-TV 9.1 (Eugene / Roseburg / Coos Bay / Corvallis)** is a participating station in the Oregon and Clark, WA, Operational Area Emergency Alert System. A total of **25** weekly and **3** monthly EAS tests covering Lane, Benton, Coos and Douglas County aired. A total of **1** national periodic test was issued for all of the United States on October **4**, 2023, and aired from 11:20 a.m. until 11:50 a.m. (KEZI1).

**KEZI 9.2** is a participating station in the Oregon and Clark, WA Operational Area Emergency Alert System. A total of **32** weekly and **3** monthly EAS tests covering Eugene and limited DMA viewing aired. A total of **1** national periodic test was issued for all of the United States on October 4, 2023, and aired from 11:20 a.m. until 11:50 a.m. (KEZI2).

**KEZI 9.3** is a participating station in the Oregon and Clark, WA Operational Area Emergency Alert System. A total of **24** weekly and **3** monthly EAS tests covering Eugene and limited DMA viewing aired. A total of **1** national periodic test was issued for all of the United States on October 4, 2023, and aired from 11:20 a.m. until 11:50 a.m. (KEZI3)

In Q3 and Q4 of 2023, KEZI 9 News collected new and gently used coats for kids in need through our annual *Coats for Kids* on-air campaign. Over 23% of children in Lane County live in poverty, and coats can be one of the most visible signs. KEZI worked together with our partners and the Eugene Active 20-30 Club to collect thousands of coats for Lane County's kids this year. KEZI 9 News promoted the campaign on-air in September and October, and held two live drive days at partnering locations. On 10/3, KEZI broadcast live reports and collected coats from 9am to 7pm at the Les Schwab store on Main Street in Springfield. And on 10/10, KEZI was out at the Les Schwab store on West 11th in Eugene, broadcasting live reports and collecting coats from 9am to 7pm. KEZI dedicated a significant amount of commercial and news time to call on viewers to help. Coats were collected and cleaned with the help of St. Vincent de Paul, and distributed to local children and families in need.

In Q4, KEZI partnered with Pacific Cascade Federal Credit Union and The Duck Store to support KEZI's annual *Santa's Little Helpers* drive. Santa's Little Helpers benefits Bags of Love, a local non-profit that provides support to children of Lane County suffering from abuse, neglect, poverty or homelessness. Bags of Love provides children with the essentials of clothing, toiletries, toys, books, school supplies and blankets, and partners with local social support services. KEZI collected and donated money and boxes filled with critical items for kids in need across all ages.

KEZI also supported the U.S. Marine Corp.'s *Toys for Tots* campaign in Q4 to help bring joy to children around Lane County. From November 11, 2023, through December 8, 2023, KEZI donated a significant amount of television airtime and provided in-news support for the Toys for Tots campaign. KEZI also held three donation drive days at partnering Bi-Mart locations, broadcasting live updates throughout the day, and calling on viewers to help donate toys on November 14th, November 28th and December 5th. 2023 was a record year for Toys for Tots, with 25,382 toys collected, which helped to support 16,110 children in Lane County. Toys were collected and given to local families in need at distribution events in Florence, Eugene, Springfield, Oakridge, and Cottage Grove.

In Q4, KEZI 9 News partnered with many local nonprofits to help raise donations and support their missions of helping people throughout Western Oregon. October through December, KEZI helped support many local events and drives, including St. Vincent de Paul through our Coats for Kids drive, the Oregon Department of Human Services-Child Welfare program, Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) of Lane County, and Bags of Love with KEZI's Santa's Little Helpers campaign. In November, KEZI also supported the Mercy Foundation's Festival of Trees fundraiser. In December, KEZI sponsored multiple community celebrations, including the Assistance League of Corvallis's Winter's Eve event, which helps to support children and their families in Benton County. KEZI also supported Christmas Storybook Land in Albany which included free activities for local families, Pastega Christmas Lights at Benton County Fairgrounds, Silverton's Christmas Market, and Roseburg's Umpqua Festival of Lights.

KEZI supports healthy lifestyles and youth sports by promoting local high school and college athletics. Friday nights from September to November, KEZI aired local high school football games during KEZI's Friday Night Blitz Game of the Week, broadcasting live from different local high schools around Western Oregon on 9/1, 9/8, 9/15, 9/22, 9/29, 10/6, 10/13, 10/20, and 10/27. In Q4, KEZI also produced a news special and provided special coverage focusing on both major universities inside KEZI's market. On Thursday, November 23<sup>rd</sup> at 6:30pm, KEZI produced a 30-minute KEZI 9 News Rivalry Game Football Special, highlighting the 2023 football seasons and upcoming rivalry game between the Oregon Ducks and the Oregon State Beavers. KEZI also sent sports reporters to the bowl games for each school, providing live local coverage to our viewers of the University of Oregon at the Fiesta Bowl in Arizona, and of Oregon State at the Sun Bowl in Texas.

Winter storms can significantly impact travel, public safety, power, and road conditions across Western Oregon. To help viewers prepare for the high winds, heavy rain, snow, ice, and blizzard conditions that can affect KEZI's viewing area each year, KEZI 9 News produced and aired an in-depth 30-minute *StormTracker 9 Winter Forecast* special on November 16, 2023, at 6:30pm. In Q4, KEZI also produced a half-hour *Top 9 Stories of 2023* news special which aired on December 29, 2023, at 6:30pm. The Top 9 Stories special highlights the major news stories that impacted Western Oregon throughout the year, what's happened since the stories broke, and how they affected KEZI's viewers.
