Newscasts are composed of news reports about the Northwest and produced by radio staff of OPB and the Northwest News Network (N3), a consortium of public radio stations throughout the Northwest.

Philosophy Talk is a weekly, one-hour radio series aired 3:00 – 4:00 am Mondays. It is produced by Ben Manilla Productions. The hosts, Ken Taylor and John Perry, have a down-to-earth and no-nonsense approach that brings the richness of philosophic thought to everyday subjects. The topics are lofty, arresting and engaging.
