

WRNA Pre-Filing Announcement

On November 25, 2011, WRNA was granted a license by the Federal Communications Commission to serve the public interest as a public trustee until December 1, 2019.

Our license will expire on December 1, 2019. We must file an application for renewal with the FCC on August 1, 2019. When filed, a copy of this application will be available for inspection at www.fcc.gov. It contains information concerning the station's performance over the last eight years. Individuals who wish to advise the FCC of facts relating to our renewal application, and to whether this station has operated in the public interest, should file comments and petitions with the FCC by November 1, 2019.
