FCC PUBLIC FILE REPORT FOR MAY 2022

Since the month of April when our community experienced the start of the Hermits Peak & Calf Canyon forest fire, the biggest forest fire in New Mexico state history, Joseph P. Baca has conducted phone and in person interviews with public information officers of the Southwest public information management team. The interviews have been held every morning of the week at 8:10 am. Forest fire officials inform the community daily on the status of the fires, possible health issues because of smoke, ash, and potential flooding with the start of monsoon season.

A phone interview was conducted by Joseph P. Baca, station owner, with New Mexico unemployment Cabinet Secretary Rick Serna to inform the public about regular unemployment and disaster unemployment benefits to people who qualify.

In studio interview with Mr. Tino Gallegos who wants to support forest fire evacuees. He enlisted the assistance of Deena Buchanan, CEO and owner of Buchanan Law Firm who strongly believes the Federal government should be held fully responsible for starting both the Hermits Peak and Calf Canyon forest fires. She will be filing a law suite against the Federal government. The attorney is offering her legal advise for FREE to those who contact her and join the law suite.

This concludes the report for May 2022. This was a slow month for radio guests. Ever since the Covid-19 pandemic hit, our guests during our talk show has slowed down tremendously. Some months we have many visitors.
