Retransmission Consent Election

Dear Mr. David:

I am in receipt of a letter from you directed to our Station WPLG (TV) Miami, in which you state that FilmOn X, LLC ("FilmOn X") intends to commence operations as a; multichannel video programming distributor ("MVPD") in Station WPLG's Designated Market Area ("DMA").

Re:

As of the date of your letter, FilmOn X does not qualify as an MVPD under the definitions of MVPD as set forth either in the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, or in the rules and regulations of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC"). See 47 U.S.C. § 522(13); 47 C.F.R. § 76.1000(e), § 76.1300(d). Accordingly, FilmOn X is not entitled to invoke the FCC's rules relating to the commencement of new operations and the election of mandatory carriage or retransmission consent by television stations that such a new MVPD seeks to retransmit.

In the event it is determined that FilmOn X's notice is proper, but without waiver of any of Station WPLG's rights, which are expressly reserved, Station WPLG hereby elects retransmission consent for all FilmOn X systems in the Miami-Ft. Lauderdale, Florida DMA for the election cycle that commences January 1, 2015, and terminates December 31, 2017.
