2nd Quarter 2019 Community Events:

Pet Picks: Each week, on magic103.com, Adam & Jenny feature 2 pets from the San Antonio Humane Society that are looking for a forever home. Pet Picks is a video segment that gives listeners special offers from the San Antonio Humane Society, and creates awareness about pet adoptions in San Antonio.

Alamo Heights Night: Alamo Heights Night is a Fiesta Event that generates revenue for the University of the Incarnate Word scholarship program. Magic 105.3 supported the event by being onsite for 5 hours, live mentions and recorded mentions.

San Antonio Humane Society: Magic 105.3 conducted various Fiesta Medal stops throughout San Antonio. With a donation to the San Antonio Humane Society (cash, food and pet items were accepted) listeners received a Magic 105.3 exclusive first year ever fiesta medal! Over \$400 was raised as well as numerous rolls of paper towels, pet toys, pet food, blakets, etc. I

El Rey Fido: El Rey Fido is a Fiesta Event that generates revenue for the San Antonio Humane Society. Adam & Jenny hosted the event, while a Magic 105.3 crew member was onsite taking pet photos. Magic supported the event by running :15 recorded promos.

Taste of the North Side: Taste of the Northside of is Fiesta Event that supports the Brighton Center of San Antonio. The Brighton Center of San Antonio provides developmental and educational services to children of all abilities by enrichment and development through an inclusive early childhood education program as well as therapy services, counseling, case management and special education support & services.

Fiesta Commission – TX Cavaliers River Parade: Magic was onsite to support the TX Cavalier's River Parade. These parades are put on by a civic, non-profit, tax-exempt organization in San Antonio, Texas, whose purpose is to teach the history of our state and to keep alive the patriotic traditions of Texas and San Antonio.

Evenings on the Edge of Topaz: Throughout the summer Magic 105.3 will be supports the Evenings on the Edge of Topaz at La Cantera Resort & Spa that benefits a different charity each week. A portion of the ticket sales, drink sales, cabana sales are donated to the charity of the week. Magic supports this event with ticket giveaways, onsite appearances and :15 promos.

Texicana's & Hotel Discotheque: Magic 105.3 teamed up with the cast of Bravo's new show based out of San Antonio called Texicana's. Magic hosted an event at Hotel Discotheque on June 25th that raised over \$3,500 for the Animal Defense League. Donations came from a silent auction and the cover charge at the door for entry to the exclusive viewing party for the season finale episode.
