Medway Family Stuck in Gaza Headed Home	News	11/3/2023	6-9am	1 min	Great news as a Medway family stuck in Gaza since the Israel-Hamas war began last month is heading home. A family spokesman announced Thursday morning that the Okal family, US Citizens who had been visiting family and got stuck trying to leave at the Gaza/Egypt border for weeks, were able to cross into Egypt early Thursday morning and were being transported to Cairo by the U.S. Bureau of Consular Affairs. The Spokesman says the Okals are deeply grateful to the Medway community for sharing their plight.

Murder-Suicide in Marlborough	News	11/30/2023	6-9am	1 min	The deaths of two people found in a home in Marlborough Wednesday morning have been confirmed by police as a murder-suicide. The Middlesex District Attorney says a 28-year-old woman was shot and killed by her 29-year-old boyfriend who

					then apparently shot himself. Police say the preliminary investigation suggests that Tuesday night the man had allegedly threatened the woman and then forced his way into her Rice Street home Wednesday morning. The incident remains under investigation.
Charges in death of Waltham Police Officer and National Grid Worker	News	12/8/2023	6-9am	1.5 min	A New Hampshire man charged with manslaughter and more for the hit and run deaths of a Waltham police officer and a National Grid utility worker Wednesday will be held without bail until at least a December 14 hearing on whether he is too dangerous to be let out until he goes on trial. Police say he plowed his truck into a work detail and later carjacked a police cruiser at knife point. In addition to manslaughter he is charged with assault with a dangerous weapon for two other National Grid workers who were hurt.
