OUTREACH INITIATIVES

1. Museum of Science and Industry's (MOSI) Hispanic Scientist of the Year Gala. Sponsored by WRMD.

This annual gala event honors the achievements of Hispanic Scientists throughout the United States. It consists of a special dinner ceremony where various sponsors, as well as high school students gather to celebrate Hispanic diversity in the sciences. This year's event was held on 10/13/14, and was hosted by Telemundo's national news anchor José Diaz Balart. Telemundo Tampa, as a sponsor, receives considerable exposure as a station interested in diversity and the educational development of our youth. The station is able to highlight its internship program, its position as a strong employer in the community, careers in broadcasting as well as celebrate students and their success.

2. La Feria de la Familia (The Family Expo) Hosted by WRMD

Mini Weather Studio

Every year, Telemundo Tampa hosts a large Hispanic Expo called La Feria de la Familia (The Family Expo). Among many of the event's attractions is a special area where a mini weather broadcast studio is set up. The event's attendees are invited to come and create a recording of their own weather broadcasts, aided by our weather presenter, Raengel Solis. Aside from its entertainment component, the Mini Weather studio also provides an educational opportunity to patrons, giving them insight into the weather presenter profession. Patrons are thus exposed to a possible career path in the television industry.

3. Tampa Advertising Federation Career roundtable

On May 20, 2015, WRMD's General Manager Jayme Ribeiro Neto participated on a special roundtable discussion on employment opportunities within the broadcast industry. Professionals from other broadcast media were also present in the panel. The audience was composed of local media professionals as well as mass communications students. Topics of discussion included possible career paths such as technical, sales, management, and on-air. All attendees were invited to keep in touch with the station for future employment opportunities.

4. Hispanic Heritage, Inc. Annual Hispanic Man and Woman of the year gala-Sponsored by WRMD

This prestigious event honors the achievements of local Hispanic leaders in the areas of community service and business. WRMD Telemundo Tampa is an annual sponsor of this event and supports it through advertising. The event is attended by business leaders as well as students. At this event, the station makes it known that it possesses an internship program and that it always welcomes resumes and employment applications.

5. Georgetown University's Master's in Journalism Program Job Fair.

April 12, 2014 Washington, DC-included National Association of Hispanic Journalists, Asian American Journalists Association, the National Lesbian and Gay Journalists Association, the Society of Professional Journalists and the Washington Association of Black Journalists. Cynthia Martinez from ZGS Communications, as well as members of the Telemundo Washington, DC news team Cristian Benavides, Sulema Salazar and Moises Linares attended to highlight opportunities across the ZGS station group. The timing of this event as well as the focus was perfect to highlight the upcoming news opportunities at **WRMD Tampa**. The station will be launching a local newscast in September of 2014.

6. Representative Janet Cruz's Job Fair. Sponsored by WRMD.

State Representative Janet Cruz's annual Job Fair was held at the West Tampa Convention Center on August 07, 2014. Our station aired promotional spots inviting our viewers to attend the event, as a sponsor of the event we were allowed to have an information desk, where we had the opportunity to share information about both careers in radio and television. Resumes were collected throughout the day; amounting a total of 25 of them.

7. WRMD-CD Marketing Department Internship Program.

Jose Ibal, marketing coordinator, hires interns throughout the year for the marketing department. The interns help in all aspects of marketing and public relations. They participate in the execution of some of the station's largest promotional events, such as La Feria de la Familia (The Family Expo) and La Buena Vida Expo (The Good Life Expo). Interns are exposed to many aspects of the television industry receiving college credit for their internships. Interns are recruited by utilizing a page on facebook, and referrals from community organizations and area educational institutions. During the time-period covered in this report the station employment unit had 4 interns.
