An on-going announcement for interns is listed on the Oklahoma Association of Broadcasters website. During the reporting period eleven college and two high school students served as paid interns learning, to varying degrees, the inside workings of a radio station.

Station personnel conducted numerous tours for "Kid DJ Day", as well as for a Christian school with a brief explanation of broadcast careers.
