



the race for governor in the republican primary....was a very
close one between bruce rauner and kirk dillard.....late
tonight, rauner gave his acceptance speech. earlier
governor pat quinn won the democratic primary against his
challenger.

for u-s senate.....state senator jim oberweis, a republican got past doug truax...and in
november, oberweis will face democratic u-s senator dick durbin.

with the last few votes...still awaiting tabulation...it appears
bill prim is headed to victory in the race for the republican
nomination for mchenry county sheriff. prim has 50 point 8
percent of the vote to undersheriff andrew zinke at 49 point 1
percent. 98 percent of the vote is in.

the republican primary for mchenry county clerk looks like its
going to mary mcclellan with 55 point 8 percent of the vote to
nick provenzano at 44 point 2 percent.

for county treasurer.....glenda miller has 54 point 5 percent to
jeffrey thorson at 45 point 4...and looks like with 94 percent

of the vote.....going to miller for the republican primary win....

mcty county board races

district one.....its robert nowak and andrew gazzar for two spots in the republican primary....

in district 3....of the four candidates...for two spots...joseph gottemoller is a clear winner....still close between donald kopsell. and nancy gonsiorek with 90 percent of the vote counted....kopsell leads for second place by 94 votes.

district 5

the winners in the mchenry county board republican primary are
john jung junior and michael rein.

district 6....

and with 93 percent of the vote counted.....michelle aavang was the clear winner for one of two spots....the second spot is still close with larry smith at 31 point six percent to ersel schuster at 30 point 6 percent...a difference of 76 votes.

it's also clear that in the countywide referendum on the future method of electing a county board chair....the voters today said they want a publically elected chair....not elected by the county board members. 57 percent yes to the referendum....42 percent no.

the countywide referendum on the question of whether the county board chair should be popularly elected--elected by the public, not by county board members. shows support for the referendum with 58 perccent voting approval of the move to a popular election versus 41 percent voting to keep the status quo with county board membrs voting on the chair.



get past the 6 to 10 inches of snow from new years eve to new year's day....and what you're faced with is....dangerously cold temperatures and wind chills ahead. this is the picture for thursday night and monday and tuesday of next week.

for now.....we've been in a winter weather advisory because of the steady snow that's covered our roads in the northwest suburbs...and brought out an army of snow plow crews. they've done what they can to stay ahead of the steady snow.... but you will encounter snow covered roads as long as the snow continues ...it's expected to let up by late today in chicagoland....not in lake and cook counties and northwest indiana where lake effect snow tonight and tomorrow will give those areas an additional 6 to 10 inches of snow.

this has been a rather light type of snow...not the heavy heart attack snow....but you shouldn't overexert yourself if you are shoveling snow....try to find someone to help...or take over the shoveling...or find someone with a snowblower.

the season's first serious snowfall....didn't wait long... i'm stew cohen....with a special update on STAR 105.5.

in what started as light snow in the northwest suburbs...turned into steady snow.....accumulating to 3 to 6 inches.....and that was new years eve and overnight....and then today...new year's day..the snow continued....bringing an additional 2 to 4 inches of snow in northern illinois.

the national weather service has also issued an advisory for lake effect snow in lake and cook counties...and in northwest indiana, where another 6 to 10 inches of snow could blanket the area.....this additional snow isn't expected to reach the northwest AND WEST suburbs though.

the area has been under a winter weather advisory.....because of steady snow --eventually tapering off....

the main roads have been icy and slick.....plowed by the crews that had worked overnight....into today...with very little time for a break. you'll have to drive slowly and recognize extra time will be needed to go anywhere.

we're handling the brunt of the snow....i'm stew cohen....with a special update on STAR 105.5.

doesn't happen often....a measurable snowfall on new years' eve and new year's day....but 2014 has started out very memorable. on new year's eve.....steady snow hit us...dumping 3 to 6 inches of snow....and then another couple of inches of snow...to add to the accumulation....giving plow crews in the northwest suburbs further direction they'd have



to work all day long today to stay ahead of the snow. fortunately, not a lot of traffic today...as many people waited for the snow to taper off.

if you are closer in to lake michigan....you'll get the lake effect snow this evening into tomorrow...and the national weather service predicts anywhere from 6 to 10 more inches of snow in lake and cook counties and northwest indiana by tomorrow.

the snow isn't the heavy wet kind...that causes snow blowers to be cleared constantly....or heart attacks...however, because of the amount of snow.....if you aren't in a condition to clear your drive and walk.....try to get some help.

whether you received 4 inches of snow.....6 inches....or more....new year's is a day of shoveling or snowblowing the measurable accumulation off your walk...and driveway....off your car.....or for some.....hunkering down for the day to wait out the snow.

the national weather service says the snow will taper off this evening....leaving behind up to 10 inches of snow as the area has had a winter weather advisory.


