

PUBLIC AFFAIRS RELATED PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

Northwest Spectrum – Sunday, October 11, 2015 6am (10-min) ECONOMY

A northwest suburban state lawmaker puts out a request to the Illinois Legislature to gather in Springfield and work out a state budget. Guest is State Representative David McSweeney, a Republican from Barrington Hills. McSweeney warns lawmakers that hesitating on this could doom many social service agencies.

Northwest Spectrum – Sunday, October 25, 2015, 6am (10-min) CRIME

Respect yourself, Be Drug Free. This is the theme of the Red Ribbon Program commonly referred to as "Say No to Drugs." Guests are student representatives from Johnsbury High School. These students attended a special ceremony at the offices of the McHenry County State's Attorney. With more incidents of heroin overdoses, it becomes more and more important to find out how young people will stay clear of drugs, especially heroin.

Northwest Spectrum – Sunday, November 8, 2015, 6am (10-min) CRIME

Cyber Safety in the Home, School, and Community...a recent symposium at McHenry County College, answered a myriad of questions on such issues as cyber in schools, cyber safety and crimes and practical tips and expectations. Guests are Melissa Hemzacek, an internet safety specialist with the High Tech Crimes Bureau of the Office of Illinois Attorney General and Jessica Wong, director of Business Development for Youth Service.

More doctors in the US are moving in the direction of only treating children with a record of vaccinations. In the case of one doctors' group in the northwest suburbs, a move away from treating unvaccinated children led to a lot of attention from the media. This past summer, Centegra Physician Care warned families of unvaccinated children of the group's decision to not treat them. This gave the families time to find other doctors. In looking for the reasons why Centegra Physician Care made this decision, Northwest Spectrum turned to Dr. Laura Bianconi, medical director of Centegra Physician Care as a guest.

[The following summarizes a representative sample of programming that provided the most significant treatment of community issues during the past quarter. Programming frequently deals with more than one issue.]

Coverage Addressing the Following Issues:

- 1) **ECONOMICS** The whole aspect of trying to find a job has changed over the years. Instead of trying to visit individual companies, people can go to the Internet or to job fairs. The northwest suburbs and Fox Valley have their share of job fairs. The Northwest Spectrum interviews State Senator Pam Althoff, a McHenry Republican on the purpose of the latest job fair at McHenry County College. 10-min.
- 2) **HEALTH** Have you ever suffered from the flu? Awful may not fully describe how sick you'll be with the flu. What should you do to protect yourself? Guests on Northwest Spectrum are Keri Zaleski, community information coordinator and Meagan Haak, promotion coordinator for the McHenry County Department of Health. 10-min.
- 3) **ECONOMICS** Habitat for Humanity of Northern Fox Valley is one of eight Habitat affiliates in Chicagoland. Northern Fox Valley enters its 25th anniversary year having begun in 1990. Over the years, Northern Fox Valley has completed 96 new construction and rehabilitation projects in Carpentersville, Elgin, St. Charles, and other communities in the Fox Valley. Guest on Northwest Spectrum is Bill Klaves, associate director, Habitat for Humanity of Northern Fox Valley. 10-min.
- 4) **COMMUNITY** Bell ringing, red kettles, online kettles, fellowship, community Thanksgiving meal, Christmas assistance, Festival of Lights Parade, Toyland Toy Shop, and Angel Tree should give you the idea that the Salvation Army Holiday Campaign has arrived. The Red Kettle Campaign is one of many campaigns of the Salvation Army of McHenry County in Crystal Lake. Guest is Captain Carol Lewis. 10-min.
- 5) **ECONOMICS** As we look to the New Year and the vitality of business in northern Illinois, we look specifically at a skilled workforce and one of the facilities to acquire the necessary skills. In McHenry, The Shah Center offers programs for the workforce, community, and business and its leaders are constantly evaluating the needs today and for the future. Guest is Dave Matts, executive director of the Workforce, Community and Business Programs at Shah Center, McHenry County College. 10-min.
- 6) **HEALTH** Called People in Need Forum brought together in one facility, organizations that dive into issues that touch every one of us, whether it's transportation options, suicide prevention, educational opportunities, changing careers, caregiving, and understanding Medicare. That was the first hour of the forum. The second full hour of People in Need Forum included the power of attorney and legal protection, heroin and drugs, homelessness and affordable housing, Pioneer Center/PADS and Home of the Sparrow, resources for children, and Family Health Partnership Clinic. Guest was Bev Thomas, coordinator of the 22nd Judicial Circuit Illinois Family Violence Coordinating Council. 10-min.

ECONOMY	OCTOBER 11	6AM	10-MIN	Illinois State Representative David McSweeney of Barrington Hills addressed the critical significance of working out a state budget and called for lawmakers to get this worked out. McSweeney stressed how social service agencies financial viability hangs in the balance.
ECONOMICS	October 18	6AM	10-MIN	State Senator Pam Althoff, a McHenry Republican examines how beneficial the job fairs are at community colleges. The latest job fair is touted by Althoff and we discuss the types of jobs available and the value of job applicant preparation.
CRIME	October 25	6AM	10-MIN	The suburbs have a problem with heroin. The suburbs have a problem with drug transactions. The state's attorneys offices in the northwest suburbs and the Fox Valley and the police departments and drug task forces are working very hard on the drug problem. One of the tools in this is a great prevention tool called Red Ribbon Week. Every year Northwest Spectrum brings its microphone to the Red Ribbon ceremony at the McHenry County State's Attorney's Office. This time Northwest Spectrum interviewed every one of the student representatives from Johnsburg High School on how they will remain drug free and how they'll spread the message to their classmates.
HEALTH	November 1	6AM	10-MIN	Northwest Spectrum uses its 10-minute program to help remind people of the importance of the flu vaccine and how important it is to avoid creating an epidemic if people chose not to get immunized. Guests are the McHenry County Department of Health Community Information Coordinator Kerl Zaleski and Promotion Coordinator Meagan Haak.
CRIME	November 8	6AM	10-MIN	Open lines of communication are extremely critical between parents and children. This is especially important for a young person using computers and other high tech equipment. Guests talked about cyber safety in the home, school, and community. Melissa Hemzacek works as an Internet safety specialist with the High Tech Crimes Bureau of the Office of Illinois Attorney General and Jessica Wong, director of Business Development for Youth Service.
