



A tornado watch is currently issued in McHenry County by the National Weather Service, after a tornado warning expired around 2:30 a.m.

The warning was issued around 1:50 a.m. and the storm was reportedly moving east from the Marengo area. By around 2:30 a.m. the storm had weakened enough to allow the warning to expire.

The watch, which means conditions are ripe for the formation of a tornado, is set to last until 4 a.m. Monday morning.

The storms have been located near Holiday Hills, as of 3 a.m., moving east at 30 miles per hour.

Affected cities include Lakemoor, Holiday Hills, Wauconda, Island Lake, Pistakee Highlands, Lake Zurich, Sunnyside, Tower Lakes, and Long Lake.

As windblown debris is still a threat, the National Weather Service is advising those in affected areas to seek sturdy shelter until the storms have passed.


