PUBLIC AFFAIRS RELATED PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

Northwest Spectrum - Sunday, July 19, 2015 6am (10-min) CRIME

The horrible reality of the senseless shootings at a church in Charleston, South Carolina and the recent attacks at an army equipment center in Chatanooga, Tennessee gives us more reason to work on our disaster preparedness. A workshop in the northwest suburbs would benefit non profits, churches, synagogues, schools, businesses, and other organizations. Churches are normally places where one goes for prayer, not a place typically associated with violence, yet the shootings in South Carolina have raised concern for a new mindset. Guests on Northwest Spectrum were Roger Dart, conference disaster coordinator Illinois Conference with Disaster Ministries of the United Church of Christ and Joy Medrano, Director of Volunteer Engagement and Disaster Preparedness.

Northwest Spectrum - Sunday, July 26, 2015, 6am (10-min) ELDERLY ISSUES

Elder abuse is very real and is a concern for many of us with elderly parents and if we are not in the situation of care givers yet, we will likely be soon. This is the story of one such (long distance) caregiver, the daughter of an elderly woman that was living in a senior citizen facility in Canada while the daughter lived in the Chicago area. Glynnis Walker Anderson, author of Stealing Joy tells how two people she initially trusted stole everything from her mother. It's a tale of warning from Walker, an investigative reporter.

Northwest Spectrum - Sunday, August 9, 2015, 6am (10-min) CRIME

Ten years ago, Turning Point, an agency combating domestic violence, hoped to raise enough money for a women's shelter. With the help of the radio station (WZSR-FM) the agency held its first 36 hour radiothon and managed to open a women's shelter, a feat that had eluded the agency for some time. Guest is Turning Point Executive Director Jane Farmer. She talks about the start of the major fundraiser ten years ago and today and how things have changed in how we as a society work to prevent domestic violence and punish the violators and help the victims.

Northwest Spectrum - Sunday, September 6, 2015, 6am (10-min) ECONOMY

Happy Hour has returned to Illinois. In signing the Culinary and Hospitality Modernization Act, Governor Bruce Rauner lifted the statewide ban that prohibited drink specials since 1989. One

of the major reasons for lifting the Happy Hour ban was that restaurant owners said it would greatly benefit the economics of the state and help them stay in business. Guest is State Representative Barbara Wheeler.

[The following summarizes a representative sample of programming that provided the most significant treatment of community issues during the past quarter. Programming frequently deals with more than one issue.]

Coverage Addressing the Following Issues:

- 1) HEALTH Illinois State Medical Society addresses the pressing medical issues over 175 years with Dr. Paul DeHaan, chairman of the Illinois State Medical Society and Dept. of Surgery Chair at Centegra Hospital-McHenry. 10-min.
- 2) YOUTH Woodstock Children's Summer Theater introduces Lion King Jr. to the Opera House Stage. This is a feel good event for dozens of children over the summer. The organization putting on the event discusses why they continue to have such challenging activities for children. The Northwest Spectrum interviews all the young lead actors and actresses and the producer Gordon Tebo. 10-min.
- 3) COMMUNITY Homemade, homegrown is the theme of the 2015 McHenry County Fair where hundreds of young people (4-H members) benefit from the event in their education. Agriculture is on display to the thousands of people coming out to the fairgrounds in Woodstock. Rich Tobiasz, vice president of the McHenry County Fair Association. 10-min.
- 4) ECONOMY The mission of Consumers Credit Counseling Service of McHenry County is to improve the quality of life in McHenry, Kane, and Lake Counties. The service promotes financial responsibility through counseling, education, and debt management services and they work with homeless shelters and try to prevent people from declaring bankruptcy. Guest is Consumer Credit Counseling Service of McHenry County Executive Director Virginia Peshke. 10-min.
- 5) HEALTH Alzheimer's destroys people, their loved ones see their memories disappear over time, but people have demonstrated they care...that's why The Walk to End Alzheimer's has raised a significant amount of money....some 67 million dollars for care, support and research efforts for those affected by Alzheimer's. Guest tells a love story about his parents, one of whom suffered from Alzheimer's and the other suffered because of what Alzheimer's did to his wife. Guests are Ira Handlesman, a Walk committee member and Jennifer Ratkovic, special events manager for the Alzheimer's Association. 10-min.
- 6) HEALTH Advisories about West Nile Virus, flu, and an assortment of other worrisome health problems are not uncommon occurances for health officials to relate to the media. Public health information officers give us the news on what outbreaks are hitting our area and on what to do to help the population protect itself from these health risks. One of the key people making public any health warning is leaving northern Illinois and her position as public information

officer...she's Deb Quakenbush. Quakenbush is one of the guests...the other is the new PIO Keri Zaleski. 10-min.

- 7) HEALTH Alzheimer's destroys people, their loved ones see their memories disappear over time, but people have demonstrated they care...that's why The Walk to End Alzheimer's has raised a significant amount of money....some 67 million dollars for care, support and research efforts for those affected by Alzheimer's. Guest tells a love story about his parents, one of whom suffered from Alzheimer's and the other suffered because of what Alzheimer's did to his wife. Guests are Ira Handlesman, a Walk committee member and Jennifer Ratkovic, special events manager for the Alzheimer's Association. 10-min.
- 8) HEALTH Access to health care is the key that truly makes an impact as stated very clearly by the Family Health Partnership Clinic preparing for its annual Care 4 Breast Cancer 5 K event in mid October. The Partnership Clinic is reaching out asking you to continue supporting the clinic and making an impact in providing access to care for many people. Guest is Suzanne Hoban, executive director of the Family Health Partnership Clinic. 10-min. September 13
- 9) ECONOMY In northern Illinois, the Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy is an effort among three counties (McHenry, Winnebago, and Boone) to enhance economic opportunity and jobs. The draft document of the Strategy for Comprehensive Economic Development should be made available in mid November to the public before it goes to the McHenry County Board for their vote. Guest is Pam Cumpata, president of the McHenry County Economic Development Corporation. 10-min. September 20
- 10) ECONOMY Thousands of people throughout northern Illinois have relied over the years on specific services that in some cases receive a portion of their dollars from the state of Illinois. We know a number of agencies hurting as a result of the state failing to work out an acceptable budget. A number of these agencies are turning to grant writing and are hoping to take money from public and private foundations...but first,...there is a learning curve in how to write successful grant applications and the Volunteer Center McHenry County is putting on a series of workshops on grant writing. Guests are Volunteer Center Executive Director Rebecca Stiemke and Family Health Partnership Executive Director Suzanne Hoban. 10-min. September 27
