Water refill stations are now available in the Airport. Because people can not take water through the screening areas, passengers are encouraged to dump the liquid portion of their bottle but keep the bottle. Then after security refilling with cold filtered water at the refill stations. Also, the goal is to make it very easy for travelers to recycle. Such initiatives include co-located trash and recycle bins through the airport. There are more than 200 airport-wide. They try to put them as close as we can so when passengers are walking through the airport, they don't have to go more than 100 feet to find a recycling can. The Airport generates approximately 10,000 tons of waste every year. Currently, we are recycling about 25% of that. The goal, however, within the next three to four years is to get that number to a 50% increase year over year.
