Section I: Issues

The stations have identified the following topics as significant issues in our community this quarter:

- A. **FAILING AMERICA'S TEACHERS**: Teachers across the country and locally are fighting to keep up with the workload and effect of the education system post-pandemic. Teachers throughout the nation are fighting long hours, low pay and constant changes each year.
- B. **MASS TRANSIT IN AMERICA:** Many Americans locally as well as around the country rely on mass transit. Being in a city, you see how important this transportation option is to local residents. With cost of living continuously increasing, many are relying solely on mass transit.
- C. **BIG QUARTER OF LAYOFFS**: The mass layoffs that happened this quarter have affected many Americans. This affected the country as a whole as well as many people around our local area.
- D. **GENDER PAY GAP**: It's reported that the average American woman earns 82 cents for every dollar earned by a man. This is still an issue across the country, and in Connecticut, the current gender pay gap averages at woman making 83 centers per every dollar a man makes. As cost of living continues to rise in Connecticut, this continues to be an issue.
- E. **FOOD MARKETING CONTRIBUTES TO OBESITY**: With the way companies are able to market now adays, it is easy for companies to promote unhealthy diets. As childhood obesity is one of the most chronic diseases in the country, food marketing can be a direct correlation of that. Connecticut's current percentage for childhood obesity is 16.8%.
