### **OUT OF BOUNDS**

- It was the girl crush that became a crime Kaitlyn Hunt, 18, engaged in a sexual relationship with a 14-year-old in the high school they attend. She is charged with lewd and lascivious battery of a child. But is the reason Hunt is being targeted because hers was a same-sex relationship?
