## ABC NEWS PROGRAMS - Second Quarter, 2012

### PRIMETIME: WHAT WOULD YOU DO?

When you think no one is watching... what would you do? Called "a Candid Camera of Ethics" by The Columbia Journalism Review, the popular ABC News series **Primetime: What Would You Do?** returns with all-new scenarios.

#### Friday, April 6, 2012

- **Roadside Assistance:** Will people stop and help a man having difficulty changing a tire on the side of a busy road? What if the stranded motorist is a woman?
- **Lotto Scam:** In these troubled economic times, more and more people are playing the Lotto. What happens when a store clerk turns out to be a crook and tries to pocket the winning ticket of his customers? Do people stand up and do the right thing? And what happens when the clerk offers onlookers a piece of the action?
- **Stuttering:** At an ice cream shop, a teen has trouble ordering because she stutters. How will fellow customers react?
- **Gold Digger:** A young, attractive woman sits at the bar with her fiancŽ -- a much older man. All she can talk about is shopping, going to expensive restaurants, presents, convincing him to buy another house, etc. But when he goes to the restroom, the woman confides in the bartender, telling him she can't wait for her fiancŽ to die so she can get his money and finally marry someone her own age. Will anyone warn the older man? What happens if the couple is an older woman and a younger man?

#### Friday, April 13, 2012

- **Kids cheating on SATs:** SAT test taking has made news recently as several high school kids have had other people take the test for them. So what would happen when "WWYD" sets up a scenario at a cafŽ where a college student and high school student discuss making a deal to cheat on the SAT?
- **Autistic Kids (Autism Awareness Month):** When an autistic child has a meltdown at a restaurant, and a fellow patron complains, how will others react?
- **Pawn Shop Con:** In a pawn shop, a customer claims to have a rare item. When the pawn shop owner goes in back to finalize the deal, the seller confesses to the bystander that the item is fake. Will the bystander say anything?
- **Spring Break - Naughty Videographer:** "WWYD" previews its Spring Break edition -- airing April 20 -- with a look at how bystanders will react to a creepy filmmaker who is trying to lure naive spring breakers into his hotel room to take pictures of them, promising stardom.

Friday, April 20, 2012

- **Watch My Ice Chest:** A college student asks a group of unsuspecting beachgoers to watch his ice chest while he steps away, at which point another student helps himself to a few bottles from the cooler. Will the beachgoers stop the theft or will they join in on the “free” beverages?
- **Sloppy Spring Breaker:** A college girl who has had too much to drink can’t find her friend to take her home from a bar. What will bystanders do when a guy on the prowl steps in, clearly looking to take advantage of her?
- **Superficial Spring Breaker:** Spring Break is all about the bikini. So what will happen when a college girl tries on bikinis at a local store, but she doesn’t have the figure to fill it the way her boyfriend thinks it should and he tells her she looks terrible? Will the other customers stand up for her?
- **Queen B’s:** Will any bystanders at a bar step in when a young college girl is being peer-pressured by her friends to take shots and get wasted in order to fit in their group?

Friday, April 27, 2012

- **Sex-ting:** A teen-age girl at a cafe is about to send a revealing photo of herself by text to her boyfriend. Will other patrons step in? And later, when the teen-age boy receives that revealing photo from his girlfriend and is pressured by his two friends to forward the photo to the whole school, will any fellow diners stop them?
- **Bike Theft:** As racial profiling continues to top the news, “WWYD” is bringing back one of the most racially-charged scenarios -- what happens when a thief snatches a bike in broad daylight in a crowded park? To find out, “What Would You Do?” set loose a trio of thieves – white male, black male and female – armed with bolt-cutters, hacksaws and a fierce-looking electrical grinder, in full public view. And what happens when the culprit is a sexy young woman in shorts and a tank top? Well, you won’t believe it. (OAD: 5/7/10)
- **Ruined Masterpiece:** At a gallery, a woman spills coffee on an expensive painting. Will other gallery goers cover for her or rat her out?

Friday, May 4, 2012

- **Inappropriate Parent:** Will anyone in a restaurant say anything when a middle-aged father starts to hit on his son's 20-something girlfriend as soon as the son leaves the table for the bathroom?
- **Velvet Rope:** Two girls hoping to enter a nightclub are refused admission by the bouncer who says they are not thin enough. Will anyone else in line stand up for the girls?
- **Transgender Discrimination:** What would YOU do if you witnessed a customer at a diner harassing a waitress because she used to be a he?

Friday, May 11, 2012

- **Extreme Couponer:** It happens frequently - a shopper at a grocery store using coupons at the cash register to get the best prices possible. But what if the shopper took excessive amounts of time sorting and handing the cashier her numerous coupons? How will the people in line behind the "extreme couponer" react? Submitted by: Grand Prize finalist Douglas Roberts from Johnston, Rhode Island.
- **Large Family Discrimination:** When a waitress at a restaurant verbally harasses a mom for having eight kids (all eating with her), will any fellow diners come to the mom's defense? Submitted by: Grand Prize finalist Trena Shines from East Palo Alto, CA.



- **Something Borrowed:** Like the movie/book "Something Borrowed," a woman is talking to her maid of honor and fiance about their wedding details. When she goes to the bathroom, it becomes clear the maid of honor and fiance are having an affair. Will any bystanders tell the bride?

- **Careless Pharmacist:** What would YOU do if you saw a pharmacist loudly disclosing potentially embarrassing information regarding a prescription pick-up about someone waiting in line? Will anyone tell our loudmouth pharmacist to tone it down? Submitted by: Melissa Derryberry from Berkley Springs, West Virginia.
- **Special Delivery:** When a worker at a mail center drops a box, breaking the contents, will he come clean and tell the woman who is there to pick up the package? Submitted by: Christina Hauck from Vancouver, WA.

Friday, May 18, 2012

- **Free Daycare:** Will any bystanders say anything when a mom leaves two children alone in a toy store, using the area for free babysitting?
- **Corrupt Counselor:** What would you do if you saw a personal injury lawyer advising his client to cheat the system? At a diner, you overhear a conversation that is decidedly deceptive, as the attorney instructs the victim to misrepresent facts, figures and their recent fall – all to make a quick buck. Would you intervene?
- **Kid Driver:** Taking a page from recent headlines, “WWYD” sets out to see what will happen when a visibly intoxicated father asks his young son to serve as his designated driver. What if it is an intoxicated mother and daughter? (OAD: 1/20/12)
- **Gay Marriage Proposal:** Right after a man proposes to his boyfriend at a restaurant, a fellow diner voices his disgust and disapproval. How will onlookers react... will anyone defend the newly engaged gay couple? (OAD: 1/27/12)

Friday, May 25, 2012

- **When “I Do” Becomes “I Don’t”:** A young, engaged couple are at a diner when the woman confesses to her fiancé that, even though she's told him she's a virgin (something mandated in the Mormon faith before marriage), she actually isn't – and hopes he will still marry her. The fiancé is shocked and tells his soon-to-be-bride that he cannot. Will fellow diners say anything?
- **Diner Dispute:** Will anyone come to the aid of a woman who shows signs of being both physically and verbally abused by her significant other?
- **Dad, I've Got A Secret:** Will anyone react to a teen boy who tells his unsympathetic father he is gay?
- **Sticky Fingers:** Will any bystanders intervene when a woman steals merchandise from a ski store? What if the thief is a former beauty queen?

Friday, June 1, 2012

- **Teen Bikini Fat:** A mother yells at her teenage daughter for wearing a revealing two-piece that she isn't “in-shape enough” to wear. She tells her to work out more and lose some weight before putting that bikini on again. Will anyone say anything? (OAD: 3/18/11)
- **Wife Bikini Fat:** A husband berates his wife for wearing a bikini too soon after she has given birth to their new baby – telling her she looks fat and needs to lose the extra baby weight before he is willing to be seen with her while she's wearing *that*. How will bystanders react? And what if it's the man out of shape? (OAD: 11/19/10)

- **Gastric Bypass: Dr. Oz** joins John Quiñones to see what will happen when an overweight teenage girl tries to resist her in-shape mom who is urging her to get high-risk gastric bypass surgery. In a twist, what will happen if the girl is trying to convince her mom that she wants the surgery? (OAD: 4/15/11)
- **Work-out From Hell:** Health clubs and fitness centers around the country are more popular than ever, but they're also a hotbed for bad behavior and lack of respect for others. "WWYD's" hidden cameras look at etiquette at the gym – will anyone speak up when a man monopolizes the equipment, or refuses to clean up his weights, or chats on his cell phone while others wait their turn? And what will happen when the "WWYD" "gym member" enters a gym class late and continues to disrupt the class by talking and laughing. (OAD: 3/11/11)

Friday, June 8, 2012

- **Surrogate Scam:** A pregnant teenage girl waits at a diner for the arrival of the adoptive parents for her soon-to-be born child. The couple arrives and the pregnant teen tells them everything they want to hear. She thanks them for the money they gave her, and then asks for more. Before leaving, the couple complies. Shortly after, another couple joins the pregnant teen. The pregnant teen proceeds to ask this Couple #2 for money as well. Will any on-lookers stop this scam in progress? (OAD: 5/13/11)
- **Online Scams:** At an internet café an older woman is having trouble with her computer and asks another patron for help wiring money to a man half way around the world for what she believes is a fantastic opportunity. It is pretty clear that she is being scammed. Will bystanders come to her aid? (OAD: 2/25/11)
- **Pawn Shop Con:** In a pawn shop, a customer claims to have a rare item. When the pawn shop owner goes in back to finalize the deal, the seller confesses to the bystander that the item is fake. Will the bystander say anything? (OAD: 4/13/12)
- **Conniving Customers:** What will happen when two young men try to scam a restaurant for a free meal by putting a bug in their soup? Will other diners turn them in, and does it matter if the scammers are two young women? (OAD: 1/20/12)
- **Fake Panhandler:** Imagine sitting down in a local outside café/park when you see a woman get out of her car and, before your eyes, transform from dressed up to dressed down. She pulls out a cup/sign and sets up shop to ask for spare change. What would you do? Would it make a difference if it was a man? (OAD: 11/5/10)

### **EXTREME PARENTING**

- **Bribery for Good Behavior** : Barbara Walters asks: What's a parent to do to get their child to behave? She talks to wealthy Las Vegas mom Lana Fuchs who bribes and rewards her daughter with huge gifts. Even some schools have been using bribery as a tool, does it work?
- **Trigger Happy**: Tommy Jordan - a strict Texan disciplinarian, the father of an 15 year old girl, became famous when he angrily shot his daughter's laptop as a punishment after she made negative remarks about her parents on Facebook. The video went crazy viral, the dad discuss his comprehensive - and controversial - parenting techniques with Sharyn Alfonsi. Dr. Phil came out strongly against Mr. Jordan.
- **Barbara and the 7 Dwarves**: Barbara Walters takes us to the home of two little people who insist that their five children live in a normal scale house to force them to adapt to a normal sized world. It's a controversial issue in the world of little people since most scale down their homes to a smaller size.
- **My Parents are Always Naked**: What happens when kids bring friends home from school and their parents are nudists? John Berman spends some time with nudist families and asks about the pressures the parents' unorthodox choice has created for their children.
- **The World's Worst Mom**: Lenore Skenazy allowed her 9 year old son to take the subway on his own and was widely criticized. Now, she's doing interventions where she goes into the homes of helicopter parents who just can't stop hovering over their kids.

### **THE BIG FAT BUSINESS OF LOSING WEIGHT - Cuomo**

- **Celebrity Endorsements**: Kirstie Alley, Jennifer Hudson, Valerie Bertinelli – they're all celebrity spokespeople for the 690 billion dollar weight loss industry. Deborah Roberts reports.
- **Diet Science Fiction**: Pills, powders, shakes, additives, there are so many products being sold to help with weight loss – Chris Cuomo takes a look at what does and actually what doesn't work.
- **The Quick Fix**: A young woman in Florida wants to look perfect when she gets married, so for the two weeks leading up to the wedding, she lives her life with a feeding tube, as if she were a coma patient on life support. That's the latest extreme form on dieting, but everyone is looking for the quick fix.
- **Bariatric Friends and Family**: We follow a young woman for over a year as she loses more than 100 pounds through bariatric surgery. She ends up changing her life completely and talking her mom, her sister...everyone around her... into having the surgery. But is this really the ultimate fix?
- **1800 Get Thin**: A Brian Ross investigation into the most successful West Coast lap-band mill...including a confrontation with the doctors behind the company.
- **Chocolate yes, but only at 4pm**: There's always someone making money off another bunch of suckers for a new diet...Nick Watt goes in search of an expensive fad diet that appeals to the world's wealthiest – a spa in Switzerland where you can eat greasy food in the morning, chocolate at teatime, and a glass of champagne at dinner. Can it possibly work? They call it chrono-nutrition.

Friday, May 18, 2012

- **Misophonia:** Elizabeth Vargas reports on Taylor, a 14-year-old who has attempted suicide twice due to misophonia – a hatred of sounds, not loud or harsh sounds, but subtle, everyday and unavoidable sounds like chewing, swallowing, sniffing, talking and even breathing. Taylor’s biggest trigger is her own mother. Is there a cure?
- **PICA**, a condition where kids crave inedible objects, like cardboard and glass. But what happens when that child becomes an adult and those cravings only get stronger and the object more bizarre? John Berman introduces viewers to a 41-year-old woman who says she has PICA.
- **Gelastic Seizures**, a spontaneous, uncontrollable and often maniacal giggle or laugh that can signal a potentially devastating, even fatal future. The cause: a rare form of epilepsy, Hypothalamic Hamartoma (HH), in which a non-cancerous tumor or lesion wreaks havoc in a highly sensitive area near the brain’s stem. “20/20” follows two young boys whose doctors journey to the center of their brains in a new, high-risk experimental surgery to make the laughter stop. Deborah Roberts reports.
- **Chronic Lyme Disease & Bartonella:** Elaina Powell has suffered with the debilitating and bewildering effects of a parasitic bacterial infection that manifests in bizarre ways. Her official diagnosis is chronic Lyme disease and Bartonella, but even her specialist agrees her symptoms are unprecedented. Years of aggressive drug treatment have provided sporadic relief, and her doctors have been criticized for treating an illness the very authenticity of which many question. Strange affliction or teenage hysteria? Jay Schadler reports.

Friday, May 25, 2012

- **Good Samaritan:** Travis Forbes claimed to be the last person to help Kenia Monge as she drunkenly stumbled away from a downtown nightclub. But his story unraveled when surveillance cameras show him wheeling a sealed cooler into his workplace, putting on latex gloves, and turning off the security system. And still it would take another terrifying attack months later before detectives could lock him away for good. Chris Cuomo reports
- **Toxic Neighbors:** They say good fences make good neighbors. But what about video cameras and the internet? They are increasingly playing a role in neighborhood feuds. The results range from ridiculous bickering to high drama, all caught on camera and posted on the internet. But cameras can also document serious misbehavior, even neighbor-on-neighbor crimes. Jim Avila reports on this eye-opening trend.
- **Pets:** Not all “criminals” are human... meet some of the animal species who have had their mischievous acts caught on tape!
- **Store Clerks Fighting Back:** Internet video sites are loaded with surveillance camera scenes of armed robberies caught in the act. Some of those videos show clerks and even customers fighting back against the bad guys. What are the real consequences when victims attack? Deborah Roberts digs into the aftermath of two dramatic and violent armed robberies.

Friday, June 1, 2012

- **Girl Crime Ring:** An alleged Eastern European crime ring used sexy women to lure vacationing men into their questionable Miami nightclubs. Once inside, they got the men drunk and, investigators say, racked up huge and often fraudulent tabs on their credit cards. But one man who was victimized, TV weatherman John Bolaris, fought back and spurred an FBI investigation and bust. Chris Cuomo takes viewers inside the undercover investigation.
