PRIME TIME: WHAT WOULD YOU DO?

Friday, October 5, 2012

GERMAPHOBIA: A lady suffering from mysophobia (fear of germs) walks into a grocery store and is too afraid to touch the shopping carts or baskets. Instead, she opts to try to carry all of her groceries to the front in her arms. As she nears the front register, it all drops to the floor, triggering an anxiety attack. Howie Mandel in disguise shows up and asks what happened. He rolls his eyes and says they just cleaned the then physically tries to hand her a basket. Will anyone stand up and defend her?

HEALTHIER OPTIONS: A customer walks up to a cashier at a grocery store and places items on the checkout counter. But as the cashier (Howie Mandel in disguise) starts ringing up the items, he starts recommending different, healthier options. As the health-conscious preaching goes on and on, will anyone stand up for their right to eat unhealthily?

BREASTFEEDING TOT: Breastfeeding in public is controversial, but even more controversial is the subject of the age at which breastfeeding should cease. So what would you do if you saw a mother publicly breastfeeding her toddler?

COOL DAD: At a liquor store, a father is buying his teenage son alcohol for a party with his friends. Will anyone confront the dad or tell the store manager?

PICKPOCKET: What would you do if you saw a mother and her young children operating as pickpockets in a busy grocery store, stealing from purses left momentarily on shopping carts?

INSULT COMIC: What would you do if you were at a comedy show and one of the comedians was insulting audience members, including two overweight women and an older man with an attractive young Asian woman.

UNDERAGE: Since the drinking age became 21, there have been many debates about underage men and women being able to serve overseas, fight battles and die for their country -- but not being able to legally have a drink. What would you do if you saw two young service members being refused a drink after they've just come home from serving overseas? What if they asked you to buy them a drink? Would you do it?

VINTAGE BOTTLE: When a clumsy customer accidentally breaks a very rare, expensive bottle of wine and pretends she has nothing to do with it, even placing the blame on other customers, will anyone in the store speak up? What if the clumsy customer casts the blame on a store employee who does not speak English?

TANNING MOM: A pale teenage girl is pressured by her mom to get a tan because she looks "unhealthy". The daughter makes it clear that she doesn't want to, but the mother persists that she won't be beautiful unless she gets in the booth. Will anyone waiting for their own tan stand up for the daughter's wishes?

THE HELP: When a mom verbally abuses the woman she has hired to take care of her kids, will any bystanders step in and say something? What if it's the child abusing the nanny?

WHO WANTS TO BE A MILLIONAIRE: Thousands of hopeful "Who Wants To Be A Millionaire" contestants line up outside a New York City studio to take a written multiple choice audition test that could get them on the show. So what would you do if the test-taker next to you started cheating? Will any real auditioners stand up to our cheaters before they go on to try and win it all?

COSTUMES: Shopping for a Halloween costume can be stressful enough, but what happens when a child insists on dressing in a costume that's meant for the opposite gender? Will anyone say anything?

WAR OF THE ROSES: When a cashier questions a man who is buying two diamond bracelets at a jewelry store, one for his wife and one for another woman, will any other customers say anything?

DIET: When a mom forces a very restrictive diet on her young daughter at a restaurant, not letting the girl order what she wants from the menu, will fellow diners say anything?
