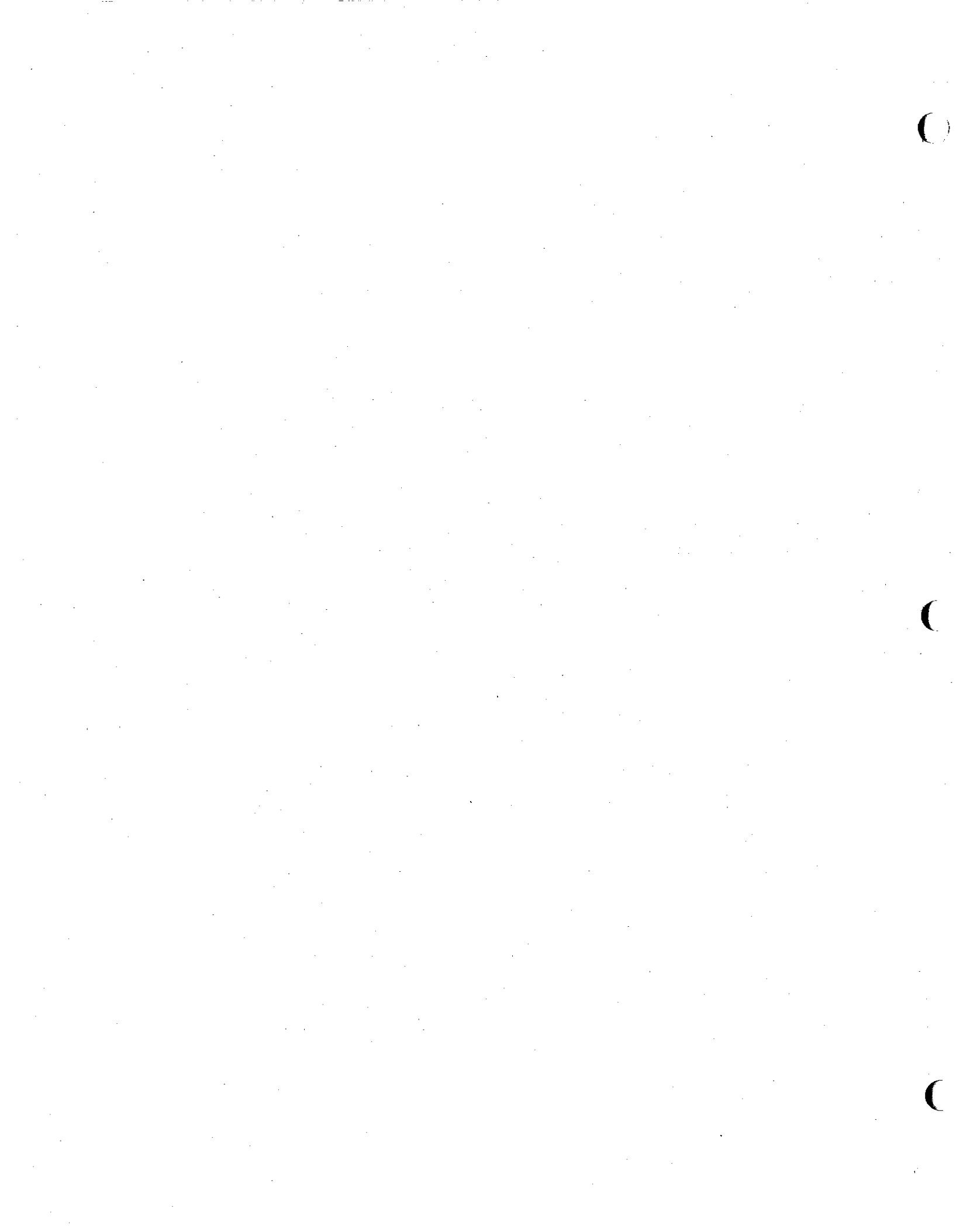

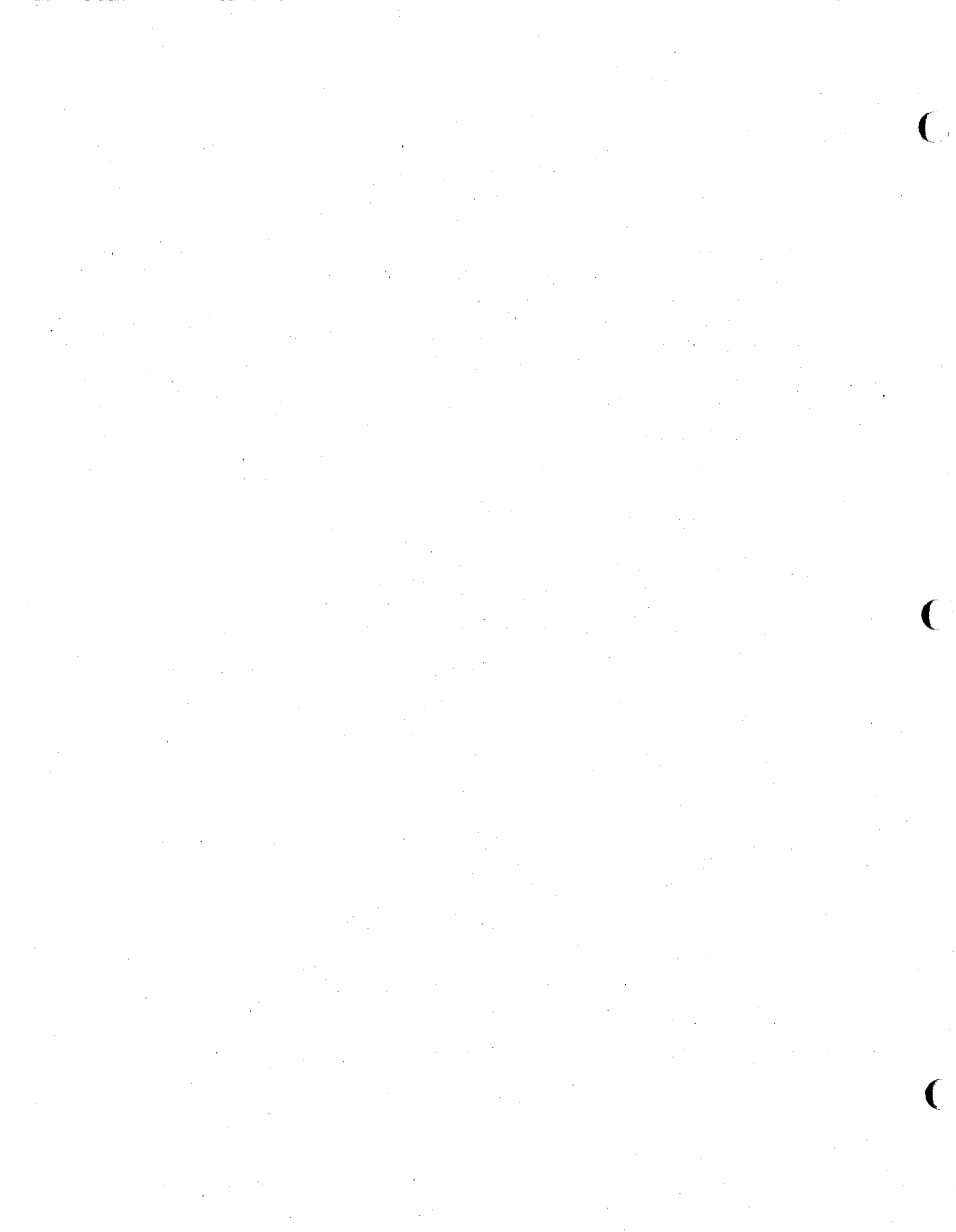

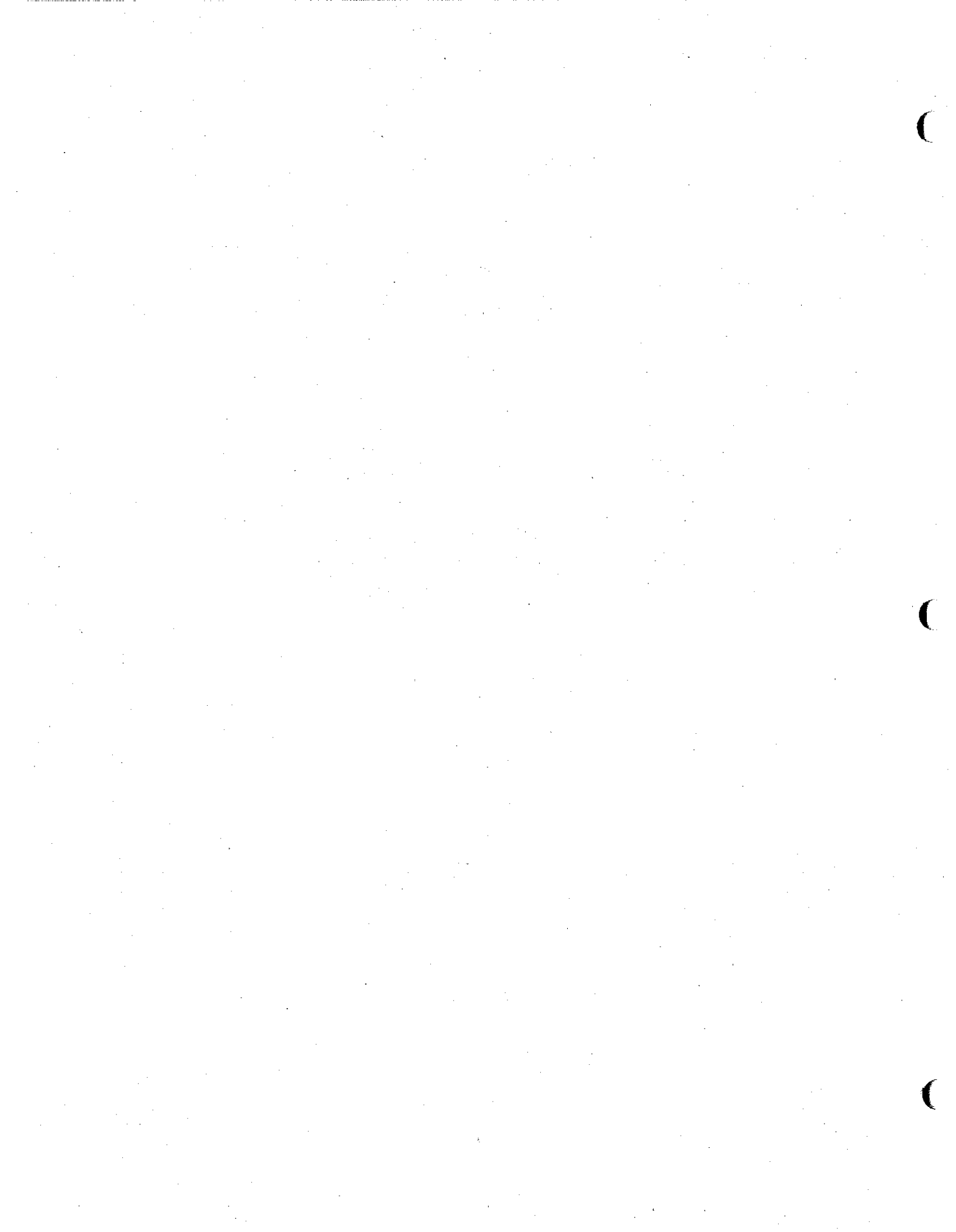

PRIMETIME: WHAT WOULD YOU DO?

When you think no one is watching... what would you do? Called "a Candid Camera of Ethics" by The Columbia Journalism Review, the popular ABC News series **Primetime: What Would You Do?** returns with all-new scenarios.

Friday, January 20, 2012 (Season Premiere)

- **Cover it Up:** A person with a very obvious birthmark visits a busy make-up counter and asks for help selecting a new lipstick. The make-up artist instead insists on offering products to cover-up her face. Will other customers say anything?
- **Conniving Customers:** What will happen when two young men try to scam a restaurant for a free meal by putting a bug in their soup? Will other diners turn them in, and does it matter if the scammers are two young women?
- **Kid Driver:** Taking a page from recent headlines, "WWYD" sets out to see what will happen when a visibly intoxicated father asks his young son to serve as his designated driver. And what if it's an intoxicated mother and daughter?
- **Gay Husband:** How will onlookers react when a husband starts kissing a male lover, who had been sitting at the restaurant bar, the minute his wife leaves for the bathroom?

Friday, January 27, 2012

- **So You Want to be a Model?:** What would you do if you were sitting in a cafe next to two beautiful teen girls when a man approaches them, offering to make them famous? He says he is a photographer, with a studio in his home, and he'd be happy to take their photos. The girls are exuberant at their being "discovered" and squeal with delight as the "photographer" leaves to place a phone call and make all the arrangements. Will anyone advise the giddy girls that it isn't such a good idea?
- **Gay Marriage Proposal:** Right after a man proposes to his boyfriend at a restaurant, a fellow diner voices his disgust and disapproval. How will onlookers react? Will anyone defend the newly engaged gay couple?
- **Doggie Adoption:** A couple seems to want to adopt a rescued pit bull from a pet store for all the right reasons - to provide a good home. But as soon as the pet store employee walks away, they let it be overheard by bystanders that their true motive is to use the dog in underground dog fights. Will anyone intervene?
- **Laptop Thief :** What will happen when someone steals a laptop left on a cafe table by a man who has asked the other cafe patrons to watch it? Will it matter if the laptop's owner is an obnoxious business man?

Friday, February 3, 2012

- **Stealing from Homeless:** Will anyone intervene when they witness someone stealing from a homeless person sitting on a sidewalk, begging for money? "What Would You Do?" plays out the scenario with the "thief" as a dressed-up businessman, a dressed-down man and a woman.
- **Bridezilla/Unhelpful Bridal Consultant:** There are shows all over television about it – brides with an insatiable appetite for being the most irrational and mean customer a salesperson could ever have. Will anyone step in when they see a bridezilla in action? And what will happen when the tables are turned and the bridal salesperson is anything but helpful – even downright rude to the customer? Will bystanders intervene?

- **Little Emperors/Mom Abuse:** What would you do if you saw a young child hitting and verbally abusing mom when the child does not get his/her way? What if it were an older kid threatening to violently take action against his mom, who happens to already have a black eye?

Friday, February 10, 2012

- **Baby Monitor Mother:** A new mother sits in a bakery looking annoyed. Beside her is a fairly odd accessory – a baby monitor – monitoring a baby from her upstairs apartment. The mom asks other customers to listen because she needs a break from the baby and heads out down the street. Will the customers watch the baby, go after the mother, or call the police? What if the mother seems to be in despair instead of just needing some “time off” – will anyone try to help the mom?
- **Vegetarian/Vegan Discrimination:** In a restaurant, a mother orders a vegan meal for her child. A couple sitting at the next table tries to convince the mother and child that they need meat/protein. At one point when the mother steps away, the couple tries to get the child to eat bacon. Will anyone step in? Twist: A 12-year-old son begs his mother to eat meat, and she says no. When she steps away, he asks other patrons if he can try their food.
- **Cover it Up:** A person with a very obvious port wine stain birthmark visits a busy make-up counter and asks for help selecting a new lipstick. The make-up artist instead insists on offering products to cover-up the port wine stain. Will other customers say anything?
- **Pray Away the Gay:** What would you do if you were at a restaurant and overheard a “therapist” telling a gay teenager that it is possible to change someone’s sexuality simply by “praying it away”?

Friday, February 24, 2012

- **Paternity Test:** At a restaurant, a young woman reveals to her friend that her baby is not really her boyfriend's baby. When the boyfriend joins them and asks about how his baby is doing, will anyone tell him the truth?
- **Smoking Parents:** It's a crowded day on a beach boardwalk when people notice a woman, with an infant in a baby carrier, smoking a cigarette. The woman is making no effort to keep the smoke from the baby's face. Will anyone intervene?
- **Tattoo Pressure:** When a girl has second thoughts about getting a tattoo yet is getting peer pressure from her boyfriend to go forward with it, will anyone else at the tattoo parlor step in?
- **Unloving Nanny:** Instead of being a loving caretaker, a nanny walking down a busy suburban street belittles the little girls she is watching with derogatory comments. What will bystanders do, if anything?
- **No More Free Samples:** When a customer over-indulges in free samples at a deli counter, will other patrons alert a store employee?

Friday, March 2, 2012

- **When "I Do" Becomes "I Don't":** A young, engaged couple are at a diner when the woman confesses to her fiance that, even though she's told him she's a virgin (something mandated in the Mormon faith before marriage), she actually isn't - and hopes he will still marry her. The fiance is shocked and tells his soon-to-be-bride that he cannot. Will fellow diners say anything?
- **Diner Dispute:** Will anyone come to the aid of a woman who shows signs of being both physically and verbally abused by her significant other?

- **Dad, I've Got a Secret:** Will anyone react to a teen boy who tells his unsympathetic father he is gay?
- **Sticky Fingers:** Will any bystanders intervene when a woman steals merchandise from a ski store? What if the thief is a former beauty queen?

Friday, March 9, 2012

- **Teen Girls Peer Pressure:** Will any bystanders defend a teen girl facing peer pressure to lose her virginity?
- **Teen Boys Peer Pressure:** When two teenage boys discuss drugging their girlfriends to have sex with them, will any bystanders say anything?
- **Mom, We Need To Talk:** What will happen when a teenage boy tells his disapproving mom that he feels he was born into the wrong body and wants to start living life as a girl? Will anyone in the restaurant come to the boy's defense?

Friday, March 16, 2012

- **Devil Wears Prada:** Many young women "pay their dues" by taking assistant positions for powerful people who treat them poorly. But when a boss' bad behavior happens in a public place, will anyone come to the aid of the young woman?
- **Albinism:** Will anyone stand up for a young adult with Albinism who is being tormented by bullies?
- **Drop Dead Diva:** What will happen when a size 14 woman is rudely told by a sales clerk that the store does not have clothes that large? Will fellow shoppers say anything?
- **Buy Me Condoms/Plan B:** A teenage boy asks pharmacy customers to buy condoms for him, explaining that the pharmacist behind the counter is a family friend and he's too embarrassed to buy the condoms for himself because of his strict, conservative upbringing. "WWYD" then changes things up with a teenage girl asking customers to buy Plan B for her, under similar circumstances. Will anyone help out the teens?

Friday, March 23, 2012

- **Haircut from Hell:** Would you tell a stranger sitting next to you at a hair salon that her haircut/color is awful, or lie to boost her self esteem?
- **You're Marrying Her?:** When a sales clerk at a bridal boutique refuses to sell a bride a dress because she is marrying another woman, will any fellow shoppers intervene?
- **Found Cash:** You spot a \$50 bill on the ground. Would you take it? What if it has a deposit slip with a check for hundreds of dollars attached to it -- and it's been dropped right in front of the bank? Would you return it, deposit it or just put it in your pocket?
- **Underage Teens Looking for Alcohol:** Will any patrons of a liquor store buy alcohol for three underage teenage boys? What happens when the teens are girls?

Friday, March 30, 2012

- **Sexy Tot:** Straight from the headlines... what would you do if, at a clothing store, you witnessed a "pageant mom" revealing her young daughter's sexy outfit for an upcoming show?
- **My Two Dads:** A gay couple bring their kids to a restaurant for a family meal. But when the adults leave the table, the kids are taunted by some teenage boys sitting nearby for having gay fathers. Will any fellow diners intervene?
- **You're Walking Home!:** What happens when a mother gets fed up with her children's misbehaving in the backseat of the car – fed up to the point of forcing them out after a dispute and telling them to walk home? Will people confront the mother, or will they feel that what is appropriate punishment is better left to the mother, even if she is at the end her rope? (OAD: 5/14/2010)
- **Potty-Mouth Child:** Kids say the darndest things... When the Lily character on "Modern Family" said the F-word, it stirred controversy on and off the screen. So what would happen when a child speaks profanity at a store – will a bystander say anything?

This series looks into the lives of people with some of medicine's most amazing and extreme conditions or who have unbelievable abilities. Look back on some favorite reports and brings viewers some new, unimaginable conditions.

Saturday, March 10, 2012

Anchored by Elizabeth Vargas:

- **Children of Hoarders:** There are an estimated six million hoarders in the United States – and while they suffer tremendously from the effects of this mysterious and devastating mental illness – their families also suffer. “20/20” looks at the children of hoarders, who come clean about the shame, resentment and lifelong secrets of growing up in such conditions.
- **Crazy for Cats:** They are a mysterious breed – women who fill their homes with cats instead of kids. Vargas takes us inside the homes of women whose passion for cats has literally, driven them to extremes.
- **Alopecia:** Five million Americans suffer from Alopecia- a condition with sudden and unpredictable hair loss. Georgia was a professional hair model who has had to suffer this condition. “20/20” follows Georgia on a very personal journey to redefine beauty.

Anchored by Barbara Walters:

- **Seven... going on 70:** What happens to a family when a child's birth becomes a medical mystery? Barbara Walters reports on Kaylee Halko and Lindsay Ratcliffe, two vibrant young girls who suffer from a rapid aging disease called progeria, The disease causes children to age at 10 times the normal rate. It is incredibly rare, Barbara interviews one of the oldest surviving children with progeria and explores the secrets of aging that her body may reveal.

Saturday, March 17, 2012

- **Twisted Cheerleader:** Washington Redskins Cheerleader Ambassador Desiree Jennings, 25, had everything going for her until one day when her body suddenly stopped working, turning into a twisted, jerky mess. Her journey for answers to this mystery takes her to a controversial osteopath in North Carolina and has led people questioning whether or not her affliction is real. Jim Avila reports.
- **Kids Too Nice to Be Normal:** Williams Syndrome is a rare genetic condition -- so rare, in fact, that few people have ever heard of it. But that one, should you ever meet him or her, will likely have a personality of unforgettable ebullience and warmth. Chris Cuomo attended a camp for children with Williams, and was besieged not by formal handshakes, but by hugs and slaps on the back and a barrage of questions. 20/20 follows researchers, children and their families in their quest to make sense of this medical condition.
- **Mega-Brain:** Daniel Tammet seems unremarkable, but behind his bookish exterior lies a superhuman gift, one of the most extraordinary brains man has ever seen. Tammet is a mathematical genius, capable of astronomical calculations instantly. He says he was born with the ability to experience numbers in an exceptionally vivid way, and is also a gifted linguist, speaking 9 languages. Yet because of his Asperger's diagnosis, he cannot drive a car. Nick Watt reports.
- **Tourettes:** Tourette Syndrome, is a neuro-biological disorder that is characterized by a range of symptoms ranging from painful self abuse and rage episodes to bizarre vocalizations like barking, meowing or even vulgar and profane language. The children are helpless to control the embarrassing behavior. ABC News Correspondent Jay Schadler follows the stories of four girls and their families as they document intimate scenes from their lives in video diaries.

Saturday, March 31, 2012

- **Kids Living with Obsessive Compulsive Disorder:** Fifteen-year-old Bridget cannot hug her own parents. She fears they are somehow “contaminated,” and it has forced her to stop living at home. Rocco, 9, dissolves into tears whenever he tries to leave for school because he’s consumed by the anxiety of what could happen once he leaves the house. They have Obsessive Compulsive Disorder, a brain condition that causes irrational compulsions. David Muir takes a rare look inside the lives of the children who are truly suffering from OCD.
- **Children Living with Schizophrenia:** 20/20 reports on the challenges facing families whose young children are suffering with severe mental illness. 20/20 spent time inside the homes of these children to see what life is like. Jay Schadler reports.

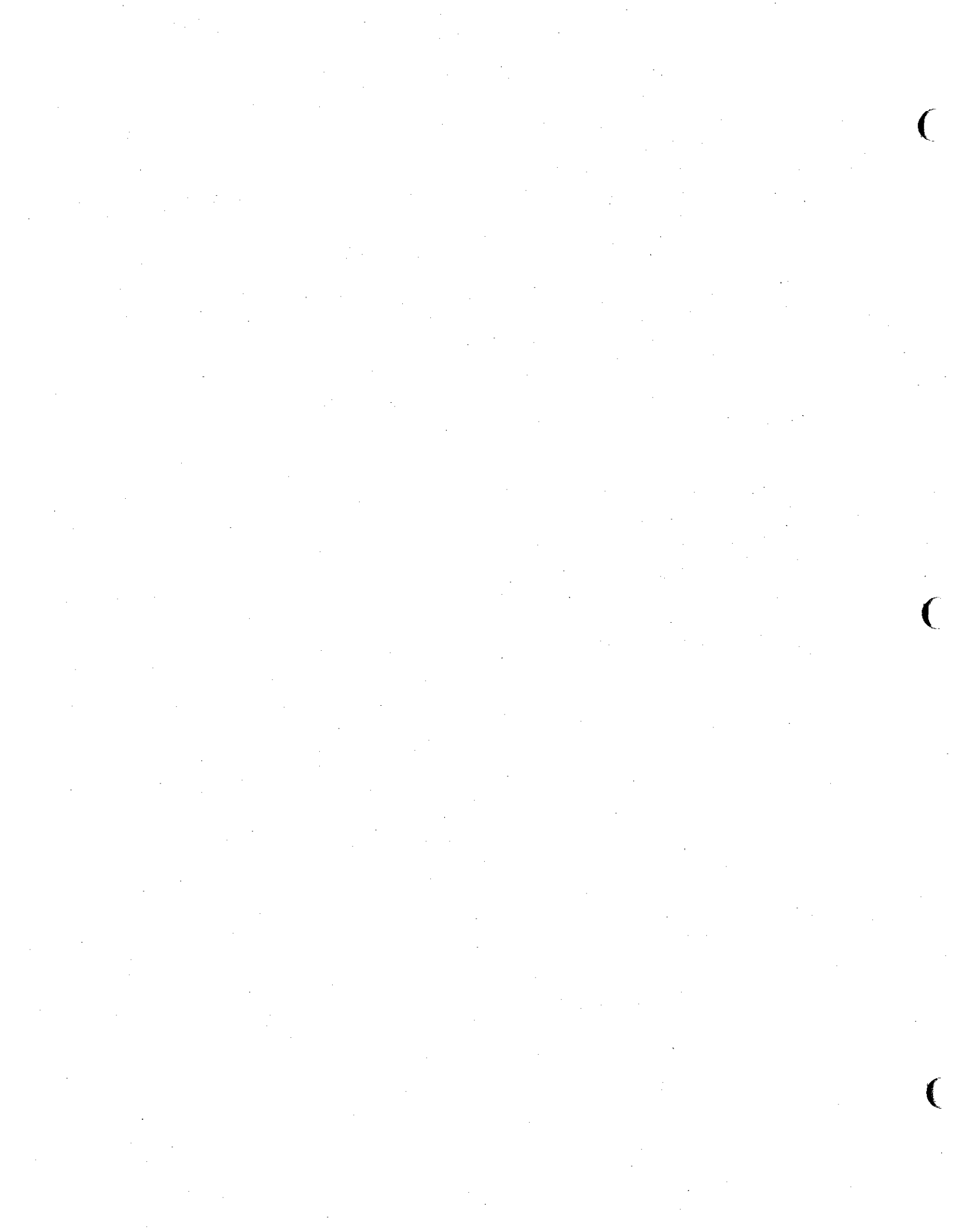

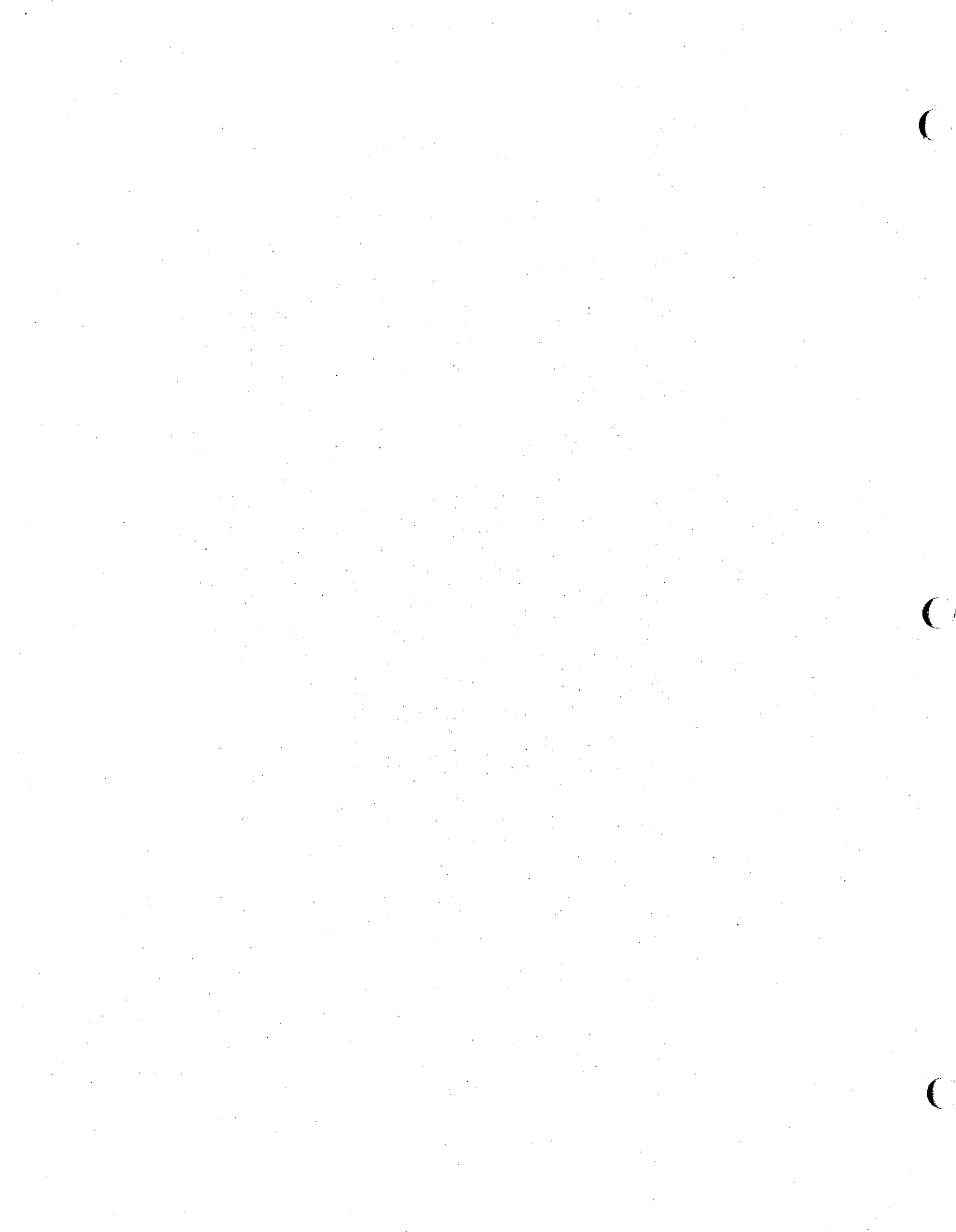
