1.	Participate in job fair	<b>February 9, 2019 -</b> WJHG took part in the 32 <sup>nd</sup> Annual Bay County Job Fair at Gulf Coast State College Panama City, FL. VP/General Manager and Promotion/Program Manager were available at the Job Fair to visit with attendees about current positions available at WJHG and other career opportunities at WJHG and in television broadcasting.
2.	Participate in events or programs sponsored by educational institutions relating to careers in broadcasting	March 20. 2019 – WJHG/WECP News Director traveled to the University of Florida in Gainesville to participate in the UF College of Journalism Career Fair Day. Students were interviewed for career opportunities in the WJHG News Department. Information was also shared with students about careers in the television industry. This was an opportunity to recruit spring and summer graduates for various openings at WJHG/WECP
3.	Participate in events or programs sponsored by educational institutions relating to careers in broadcasting	March 25, 2019 – WJHG/WECP Assistant News Director led a workshop on covering breaking news at the 1 <sup>st</sup> annual Loyola University /Gray Producer Incubator Program at Loyola University in New Orleans, LA. The workshop is an eight week program in which students in the media program are exposed to real world, real time knowledge of the media industry.
