Issue	Program	Date	Time	Duration	Description of Program
Faith	Hour of Harvest	10/1/15-12/31/15	7p-8:30p	90 min	WLJC prayer lines are available 24/7 for the viewing area to call in with their prayer requests. Callers can talk to a prayer partner which will guide them by God's word to give them a reassuring direction in life.
Cancer	Hour of Harvest	10/5,11/2,12/1	7p-8:30p	90 min	Special prayer for cancer patients. Host and guest share Bible verses that tell of God's protection, strength and inspiration. Although we have special nights for cancer prayer, cancer prayer requests called in nightly that are prayed for each evening.
Health/Sickness, Depression & Finances	Hour of Harvest	10/1/15-12/31/15	7p-8:30p	90 min	Sis. Margaret and viewers recurrently pray for the health of people in need as well as for every person. We receive many calls throughout the day and evening from people with health problems, drug addiction, depression, financial problems and other issues that are in need of prayer.
Health/Sickness	Hour of Harvest	10/1/15-12/31/15	7p-8:30p	90 min	President of WLJC, Sister Margaret Drake, frequently visits hospitals, nursing homes and homes of the viewers. She prays for the sick, shares words of encouragement and leads lost souls to the Lord. She discusses the need for prayer for those in hospitals, nursing homes, etc.
Faith	Hour of Harvest	10/1/15-12/31/15	7p-8:30p	90 min	Each evening, host and guests announce upcoming revivals, homecomings and church events and motivates the viewers to attend. Scripture is read from the Bible which enables those that cannot read to hear the Word of God.
Family/Relationship Issues	Hour of Harvest	10/1/15-12/31/15	7p-8:30p	90 min	Hour of Harvest is a religious program that airs live five nights every week for families to grow spiritually. By watching this positive family program, society is provided the opportunity to speak with prayer partners as well as to ministers to help them with salvation.

WLJC Fall Revival	Hour of Harvest	10/5/15 -10/17/15	7p-8:30p	90min	Local pastors were invited each evening to share a short sermon to encourage people to be saved and live their life according to God's word. Several souls were saved during the two weeks of revival.
WLJC Fall Telethon	Hour of Harvest	10/19/15-10/31/15	7p-10p	180min	Guest singers and hosts were invited to help fundraise for WLJC. The donations help WLJC to continue Christian broadcasting for another six months.
Family	Hour of Harvest	10/1/15-12/31/15	7p-8:30p	90min	Talks about the importance of being there for your family and the positive impression you have on the lives of those around you.
Drug Rehabilitation	Hour of Harvest	11/24/15	7p-8:30p	90min	Chad's Hope Teen Challenge is a faith-based rehab center that helps men overcome drug addiction. They have many programs such as a new woodworking program. The money they raise from their projects go into a scholarship program that pays tuition for students that come to Chad's Hope.

Hour of Harvest broadcasts “Live” on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday from 7p-8:30p and is produced in the WLJC studio with the assistance of our production staff in the main studio building. A variety of guests appear on the program from all across Kentucky as well as from several other states. Hour of Harvest provides encouraging words, gospel singing and bible scripture to viewers. WLJC also has a prayer request line that is available 24/7 for people to speak with a prayer partner. WLJC is church to countless individuals that are homebound, imprisoned, in hospitals as well as in other medical facilities, and to persons that don’t have a home church, etc.

All of the programming broadcast on WLJC is Christian programming and is clearly family based so that all ages can assemble together as a family and appreciate every program.
