Prayer Line	Hour of Harvest	1/1/08-3/31/08	7p-8:30p	90 min	Discussed that WLJC has a 24/7 prayer line available for the viewing area to call in with their prayer requests and have prayer and talk to a live prayer partner to encourage them to live by God's word.
Health	Hour of Harvest	1/8/08	7p-8:30p	90 min	Darrell Shepherd shared his testimony of healing from cancer.
