Prayer Line	Hour of Harvest	10/1/07-12/31/07	7p-8:30p	90 min	Discussed that WLJC has a 24/7 prayer line available for the viewing area to call in with their prayer requests and have prayer and talk to a live prayer partner to encourage them to live by God's word.
Health	Hour of Harvest	11/27/07	7p-8:30p	90 min	Discussed physical health and how God can heal and comfort you when you when you are sick. Importance of taking care of yourself.
Community Service	Hour of Harvest	10/1/07-12/31/07	7p-8:30p	90min	Sister Margaret personally visits hospitals, nursing homes and homes of the viewers, praying for the sick, sharing words of encouragement and leading lost souls to the Lord.
Community Service	Hour of Harvest	10/20/07	1p-4p	180min	Held special Open House celebrating 25 years on the air. Invited viewers to come tour the facility, meet the staff and share their feelings on how WLJC has encouraged and uplifted their lives. Turnout was more than we ever expected, more than 1,000 people came to visit and share testimony.
Community Service	WLJC Fall Revival	10/15/07-10/20/07	7p-8:30p	90min	WLJC Fall Revival was held with special messages and singing to invite people to turn their lives over to the Lord. Approximately 61 viewers accepted the Lord during our fall revival and telethon.
Community Service	WLJC Fall Telethon	10/22/07-11/3/07	7p-10p	180min	WLJC Fall Telethon was held to ask viewers to support the ministry so that we may continue to upgrade our equipment and continue to broadcast Christian programming.
Family	Hour of Harvest	11/16/07 11/20/07	7p-8:30p	90 min	Discussed that we need to appreciate and respect our family members. Don't take advantage of the time you can spend with them while they are living.
