Faith	Hour of Harvest	1/1/17 – 3/31/17 Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday	7p-8:30p	90 min	Hour of Harvest is a Christian faith based program designed to help viewers grow spiritually. Host and guests offer prayer, bible teaching, inspiration and southern/bluegrass gospel music.
Health/Illness (physical, emotional, spiritual and financial)	Hour of Harvest	1/1/17 – 3/31/2017 Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday	7p-8:30p	90 min	Host and prayer partners pray for the health of the viewers in need as they call in “live” their prayer requests. We receive many calls and letters every day from viewers with health problems including addictions, stroke, cancer, and other physical, emotional, spiritual and financial problems.
Community Events	Hour of Harvest	1/1/17 – 3/31/17 Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday	7p-8:30p	90 min	Host and guests announce upcoming revivals, homecomings and church events and encourage the viewers to attend. Host introduces and promotes local gospel musicians.
Family/Relationship Issues	Hour of Harvest	1/1/17 – 3/31/17 Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday	7p-8:30p	90 min	Viewers are provided the opportunity to speak with prayer partners and ministers to help support with family crisis including conflict, illness, job loss, and marital issues.
Literacy	Hour of Harvest	1/1/17 – 3/31/17 Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday	7p-8:30p	90 min	Scripture is read from the Bible which allows people that cannot read to hear the Word of God.
Elder Issues	Hour of Harvest	1/1/17 – 3/31/17 Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday	7p – 8:30p	90 Min	Issues of quality of life, such as loss and grieving, and disability are prayed for during every program.

Hour of Harvest broadcasts “Live” on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday from 7p-8:30p and is produced in the WLJC studio in the main studio building. A variety of guests appear on the program from across Kentucky as well as from several other states. Hour of Harvest provides encouraging words, gospel singing, prayer, and bible reading to viewers. WLJC also has a prayer request line that is available 24/7 for people to speak with a prayer partner. WLJC is church to countless individuals that are homebound, incarcerated, in hospitals as well as in other medical facilities, and to persons that don’t have a home church, etc.
