Prayer Line	Hour of Harvest	1/1/09-3/31/09	7p-8:30p	90 min	WLJC has a 24/7 prayer line available for the viewing area to call in with their prayer requests to have prayer and talk to a live prayer partner to encourage them to live by God's word.
Health	Hour of Harvest	1/6/09 2/3/09 3/3/09	7p-8:30p	90 min	Held special prayer for cancer patients. Shared Bible verses that told of God's protection and strength.
Community Service	Hour of Harvest	1/1/09-3/31/09	7p-8:30p	90min	Sister Margaret personally visits hospitals, nursing homes and homes of the viewers, praying for the sick, sharing words of encouragement and leading lost souls to the Lord.
Community Service	Hour of Harvest	3/9/09-3/27/09	7p-8:30p	90min	Revival was held for three weeks to encourage viewers to give their lives to the Lord and live righteous.
Community Service	Hour of Harvest	3/30/09-4/11/09	7p-10p	180min	Two weeks of telethon was held to help to raise money for operational expense. The money donated helps keep good, family Christian programming on the air.
Community Service /Public Safety	PRIDE: A Decade of Difference	3/29/09	4p-5p	60 minutes	This program is a production of Eastern Kentucky PRIDE, Inc., which looks back on the first 10 years of PRIDE and the progress the organization has made with the help of community volunteers to clean up illegal dumps and the grants PRIDE provided to numerous homeowners to install sewer systems into their homes which did not have them.
Community Service /Public Safety	In House Tour/Demonstration	3/11/09	10a-11a	60 minutes	Lee County Head Start visited the studio for a tour of the facility. Staff focused on severe weather preparedness week. Demonstrations were given on how WLJC obtains severe weather alerts and how the alerts are broadcast to the public.
