Issue	Program	Date	Time	Duration	Description of Program
Prayer Line	Hour of Harvest	10/1/12-12/31/12	7p-8:30p	90 min	WLJC has a 24/7 prayer line available for the viewing area to call in with their prayer requests. They are able to talk to a prayer partner to encourage them to live by God's word and give them an encouraging direction in life.
Health	Hour of Harvest	10/2, 11/5/12, 12/4/12	7p-8:30p	90 min	Special prayer for cancer patients. Shared Bible verses that told of God's protection, strength and encouragement.
Community Service	Hour of Harvest	10/1/12-12/31/12	7p-8:30p	90 min	President of WLJC, Sister Margaret, continually visits hospitals, nursing homes and homes of the viewers, praying for the sick, sharing words of encouragement and leading lost souls to the Lord. She discusses her visits on air with viewers so they can pray for the sick as well.
Community Service	Hour of Harvest	10/1/12-12/31/12	7p-8:30p	90 min	Host and guests announce upcoming revivals, homecomings and church events and encourages the viewers to attend.
Family	Hour of Harvest	10/1/12-12/31/12	7p-8:30p	90 min	Hour of Harvest is a program airing live five nights every week for families to grow spiritually by watching this positive family program. Gives viewers the opportunity to speak live with prayer partners and ministers to help them find salvation.
Religion	Hour of Harvest	10/8/12-10/20/12	7p-8:30p	90 min	WLJC held Fall Revival October 8-20 to encourage viewers to live their life for the Lord. Several guest preachers shared encouraging words and prayed for those who called in. Guests musicians blessed the audience with gospel singing.
Telethon	Hour of Harvest	10/22/12-10/27/12 10/29/12-11/3/12	7p-8:30p	90 min	WLJC held its Fall Telethon to raise funds for the ongoing operating/equipment cost for broadcasting Christian programming into homes across central and eastern Kentucky.

Drug Addiction	Hour of Harvest	11/15/12	7p-8:30p	90 min	Special Guest Carl Varney with Operation Unite discussed a drug rally event. Operation unite helps to fight drug addiction.
Religion	Hour Of Harvest	12/31/12	7p-mid	300 min	New Years Eve Night Watch Service was held to ring in the New Year with scripture, gospel singing, testimonies, candle lighting and preaching to save souls.
