Issue	Program	Date	Time	Duration	Description of Program
Prayer Line	Hour of Harvest	10/1/13-12/31/13	7p-8:30p	90 min	WLJC has a 24/7 prayer line available for the viewing area to call in with their prayer requests. They are able to talk to a prayer partner to encourage them to live by God's word and give them an encouraging direction in life.
Cancer	Hour of Harvest	10/1, 11/5,11/22,12/3, nightly prayer	7p-8:30p	90 min	Special prayer for cancer patients. Shared Bible verses that told of God's protection, strength and encouragement.
Health	Hour of Harvest	10/1-12/31	7p-8:30p	90 min	Sis. Margaret and viewers continually pray for the health of people in need as well as for everyone. We receive many calls throughout the day as well as evening from people with health problems in need of prayer.
Community Service	Hour of Harvest	10/1/13-12/31/13	7p-8:30p	90 min	President of WLJC, Sister Margaret Drake, continually visits hospitals, nursing homes and homes of the viewers, praying for the sick, sharing words of encouragement and leading lost souls to the Lord. She discusses her visits on air with viewers so they can pray for the sick as well.
Community Service	Hour of Harvest	10/1/13-12/31/13	7p-8:30p	90 min	Each evening, host and guests announce upcoming revivals, homecomings and church events and encourages the viewers to attend. Scripture is read from the Bible which enables those that cannot read, hear the Word of God.
Family	Hour of Harvest	10/1/13-12/31/13	7p-8:30p	90 min	Hour of Harvest is a program airing live five nights every week for families to grow spiritually by watching this positive family program. Provides viewers the opportunity to speak live with prayer partners and ministers to help them with salvation.

Creation Museum	Hour Of Harvest	12/16/13	7p-8:30p	90min	Sis. Margaret interviewed Buddy Davis from the Creation Museum in Northern Kentucky. He teaches children about Jesus and the bible through song and the museum experience.
WLJC Fall Revival	Hour Of Harvest	10/14-10/26	7p-8:30p	90min	WLJC's annual fall revival services were held with guest preachers each evening sharing the word of God to those who can't attend church and help viewers find salvation.
WLJC Telethon Fundraiser	Hour of Harvest	10/28-11/9	7p-10p	180min	WLJC held its annual fall telethon to raise funds to continue broadcasting the word of God into homes across central and eastern Kentucky.
Food Bank	Hour of Harvest	11/19/13	7p-8:30p	90min	New Hope Freewill Baptist Church was our guests tonight and they discussed a food bank they are raising money for to distribute food to families who need food during emergency situations. They have produced a cd Bluegrass Against Hunger that proceeds go to the food bank. Local musicians donated their time and songs for this cd.
