Issue	Program	Date	Time	Duration	Description of Program
Faith	Hour of Harvest	1/1/15-3/31/15	7p-8:30p	90 min	WLJC's prayer lines are available 24/7 for the viewing area to call in with their prayer requests. Callers can talk to a prayer partner which will guide them by God's word and give them a reassuring direction in life.
Cancer	Hour of Harvest	1/6,1/29,2/3,3/3	7p-8:30p	90 min	Special prayer for cancer patients. Host and guest share Bible verses that tell of God's protection, strength and inspiration. Although we have special nights for cancer prayer, we have cancer prayer requests are called in nightly that are prayed for.
Health/Sickness & Depression & Finances	Hour of Harvest	1/1/15-3/31/15	7p-8:30p	90 min	Sis. Margaret and viewers continually pray for the health of people in need as well as for every person. We receive many calls throughout the day and evening from people with health problems, drug addiction, depression, financial problems and other issues that are in need of prayer.
Health/Sickness	Hour of Harvest	1/1/15-3/31/15	7p-8:30p	90 min	President of WLJC, Sister Margaret Drake, frequently visits hospitals, nursing homes and homes of the viewers. She prays for the sick, shares words of inspiration and leads lost souls to the Lord. She discusses her anonymous visits on air with viewers so they can pray for the sick as well.
Faith	Hour of Harvest	1/1/15-3/31/15	7p-8:30p	90 min	Each evening, host and guests announce upcoming revivals, homecomings and church events and inspires the viewers to attend. Scripture is read from the Bible which enables those that cannot read to hear the Word of God.
Family/Relationship Issues	Hour of Harvest	1/1/15-3/31/15	7p-8:30p	90 min	Hour of Harvest is a religious program that airs live five nights every week for families to grow spiritually. By watching this positive family program people are provided the opportunity to speak with prayer partners as well as to ministers to help them with salvation.

Faith	Hour of Harvest	3/9/15-3/21/15	7p-8:30p	90min	The WLJC Spring Revival aired for two weeks to win souls for Christ. There were numerous viewers that were saved during these services and many gave testimonies on how WLJC has changed their lives and lives of family members.
Faith	Hour of Harvest	3/23/15-4/4/15	7p-10p	180min	The WLJC Spring Telethon aired for two weeks to raise funds to help WLJC with operating expense so the station may continue to broadcast the gospel into homes, hospitals, nursing homes, jails, etc.
Education	Hour of Harvest	2/2/15	7p-10p	90min	Sister Margaret interviewed the President of Oneida Bible Institute to discuss the campus and how they educate students about the Bible as well as other academics. He told about the history of the Christian school.
Education	Hour of Harvest	3/10, 3/11	10a-11a	60min	Lee County Headstart students from four classes toured WLJC for their severe weather awareness field trip. WLJC Staff demonstrated the procedures of obtaining severe weather statements and the process of forwarding the information on to the public.

Hour of Harvest broadcasts "Live" on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday from 7p-8:30p and is produced in the WLJC studio with the assistance of our production staff in the main studio building. A variety of guests appear on the program from all across Kentucky as well as from several other states. Hour of Harvest provides encouraging words, gospel singing and bible scripture to viewers. WLJC also has a prayer request line that is available 24/7 for people to speak with a prayer partner. WLJC is church to countless individuals that are homebound, imprisoned, in hospitals as well as in other medical facilities, and to persons that don't have a home church, etc.

All of the programming broadcast on WLJC is Christian programming and is clearly family based so that all ages can assemble together as a family and appreciate every program.
