Issue	Program	Date	Time	Duration	Description of Program
Prayer Line	Hour of Harvest	4/1/13-6/30/13	7p-8:30p	90 min	WLJC has a 24/7 prayer line available for the viewing area to call in with their prayer requests. They are able to talk to a prayer partner to encourage them to live by God's word and give them an encouraging direction in life.
Health	Hour of Harvest	4/2/13, 5/7/13,6/4/13	7p-8:30p	90 min	Special prayer for cancer patients. Shared Bible verses that told of God's protection, strength and encouragement.
Community Service	Hour of Harvest	4/1/13-6/30/13	7p-8:30p	90 min	President of WLJC, Sister Margaret Drake, continually visits hospitals, nursing homes and homes of the viewers, praying for the sick, sharing words of encouragement and leading lost souls to the Lord. She discusses her visits on air with viewers so they can pray for the sick as well.
Community Service	Hour of Harvest	4/1/13-6/30/13	7p-8:30p	90 min	Each evening, host and guests announce upcoming revivals, homecomings and church events and encourages the viewers to attend.
Family	Hour of Harvest	4/1/13-6/30/13	7p-8:30p	90 min	Hour of Harvest is a program airing live five nights every week for families to grow spiritually by watching this positive family program. Provides viewers the opportunity to speak live with prayer partners and ministers to help them with salvation.
Summer Bible Camp	Hour of Harvest	5/30/13	7p-8:30p	90 min	Guests were Bill Holman and his puppets to discuss Youth Haven Bible Camp's Summer Camp. Discussed the age groups, how to join and the activities they do there.
Telethon	Hour of Harvest	4/1/13-4/6/13	7p-10p	180 min	WLJC held its Spring Telethon to raise funds for the ongoing operating/equipment cost for broadcasting Christian programming into homes across central and eastern Kentucky.

Tornado Devastation	Hour Of Harvest	5/21/13	7p-8:30p	90min	Sis. Margaret asked the viewers to pray for the families and victims in the Oklahoma tornado disaster.
Medical Helicopter Crash	Hour Of Harvest	5/21/13	7p-8:30p	90min	Prayer was requested for the families of the victims in the medical helicopter crash that occurred in Manchester, KY killing all three crew members. Briefly touched on the fact that these women/men risk their lives daily to save others.
