Issue	Program	Date	Time	Duration	Description of Program
Prayer Line	Hour of Harvest	1/1/14-3/31/14	7p-8:30p	90 min	WLJC's prayer lines are available 24/7 for the viewing area to call in with their prayer requests. Callers can talk to a prayer partner which will guide them by God's word and give them a reassuring direction in life.
Cancer	Hour of Harvest	1/10, 1/13,1/28,2/4,3/4	7p-8:30p	90 min	Special prayer for cancer patients. Host and guest share Bible verses that tell of God's protection, strength and inspiration.
Health	Hour of Harvest	1/1-3/31	7p-8:30p	90 min	Sis. Margaret and viewers continually pray for the health of people in need as well as for every person. We receive many calls throughout the day and evening from people with health problems that are in need of prayer.
Community Service	Hour of Harvest	1/1/14-3/31/14	7p-8:30p	90 min	President of WLJC, Sister Margaret Drake, continually visits hospitals, nursing homes and homes of the viewers. She prays for the sick, shares words of encouragement and leads lost souls to the Lord. She discusses her visits on air with viewers so they can pray for the sick as well.
Community Service	Hour of Harvest	1/1/14-3/31/14	7p-8:30p	90 min	Each evening, host and guests announce upcoming revivals, homecomings and church events and encourages the viewers to attend. Scripture is read from the Bible which enables those that cannot read to hear the Word of God.
Family	Hour of Harvest	1/1/14-3/31/14	7p-8:30p	90 min	Hour of Harvest is a religious program that airs live five nights every week for families to grow spiritually. By watching this positive family program people are provided the opportunity to speak live with prayer partners as well as ministers to help them with salvation.

WLJC Spring Revival	Hour Of Harvest	3/17-3/29	7p-8:30p	90min	WLJC's annual spring revival services were held with guest pastors each evening sharing the word of God to people who are not capable to attend church and to encourage people to find salvation.
WLJC Telethon Fundraiser	Hour of Harvest	3/31	7p-10p	180min	This is the first night to kick off the spring telethon to raise funds for WLJC to continue broadcasting Christian programming into homes in the viewing area. The telethon takes place for 2 weeks.

Hour of Harvest broadcasts “Live” on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday from 7p-8:30p and is produced in the WLJC studio with the assistance of our production staff in the main studio building. A variety of guests appear on the program from all across Kentucky as well as from several other states. Hour of Harvest provides encouraging words, gospel singing and bible scripture to viewers. WLJC also has a prayer request line that is available 24/7 for people to speak with a prayer partner. WLJC is church to countless individuals that are homebound, imprisoned, in hospitals as well as in other medical facilities, and to persons that don’t have a home church, etc.

All of the programming broadcast on WLJC is Christian programming and is clearly family based so that all ages can assemble together as a family and appreciate every program.
