Re: TEGNA Election of Retransmission Consent Status (WUSA, Washington, D.C.)


Dear Mr. Kyle:

I write regarding the notification we received from Shenandoah Cable Television, LLC ("Shentel") on April 13, 2021, stating that Shentel intends to commence providing cable television service in specified communities located in the Washington, D.C. Designated Market Area on or about June 15, 2021.

WUSA-TV, Inc. ("Licensee"), a subsidiary of TEGNA Inc. ("TEGNA"), is the licensee of broadcast television station WUSA, Washington, D.C. ("WUSA"). TEGNA, on behalf of Licensee, hereby gives notice to Shentel that Licensee elects retransmission consent status for WUSA pursuant to Section 325(b)(3)(B) of the Communications Act and Section 76.64(k) of the rules of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC"). This election applies to all cable and other video distribution systems that Shentel or its affiliated entities own, operate, or manage. Accordingly, pursuant to Section 325(b)(1)(A) of the Communications Act and Section 76.64(a) of the FCC's rules, WUSA's broadcast signal may not be carried on Shentel's cable or other multichannel video programming distribution systems without Licensee's express written consent pursuant to a retransmission consent agreement. This election of retransmission consent applies for the period January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2023.
